New Delhi, July 14 : Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy urged Union Minister for Civil Aviation Rammohan Naidu to ensure the upcoming new airports at Warangal (Mamnoon) and Adilabad be constructed at international standards.

The Chief Minister highlighted the strategic and commercial advantages of the two new airports in view of its locations in Telangana state. Revanth Reddy met

BRS steps up attack on Congress over Kaleshwaram project operations

Hyderabad, July 14 : Stepping up its campaign over the Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Project (KLIP), the Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) on Tuesday accused the Congress government of aggravating irrigation and drinking water shortages by failing to operate the Kannepalli pump house despite substantial inflows into the Godavari River

at Medigadda. At a press conference held at Telangana Bhavan, former minister and Karimnagar MLA Gangula Kamalakara alleged that nearly nine TMCft of water was flowing downstream every day while crops in the Lower Manair and Mid Manair command areas were withering due to inadequate water supply. He urged the State government to immediately

resume pumping operations, saying it should "set aside its ego" and act to protect standing crops. The BRS MLA claimed that North Telangana was facing a severe water crisis and questioned why State ministers had not visited Karimnagar to assess the situation. He also accused Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy of misleading the public for political reasons.



Suresh Gopi urges students to champion cleanliness & Environmental protection

Hyderabad, July 14 : Union Minister of State for Petroleum & Natural Gas Suresh Gopi on Tuesday urged the students to become ambassadors of cleanliness and environmental conservation, describing Swachhata as a culture of personal responsibility and public participation rather than just a campaign.



Bhatti blames BRS for pushing Telangana into 8.21 lakh crore debt trap

Hyderabad, July 14 : Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka strongly criticised the previous BRS government, stating that it looted the state and pushed it into a massive debt trap of 8.21 lakh crore. He said that when they handed over the state earlier, it was financially strong with a surplus

budget, but due to a decade of misgovernance, corruption, and poor decisions by the previous rulers, Telangana has been reduced to a debt-ridden state. Addressing a public meeting held at Julekal village in Vaddepalli mandal of Alampur constituency on Tuesday.

Congress leaders urge extension of SIR deadline in Telangana

Hyderabad, July 14 : A delegation of Congress leaders has formally requested the Election Commission of India (ECI) to extend the deadline for the ongoing Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls in Telangana. Led by Hyderabad in-charge Minister Ponnamm Prabhakar, the delegation met Telangana Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) C. Sudarshan Reddy on Tuesday. The team included MLCs Addanki Dayakar and Balamuri Venkat, MLAs Sri Ganesh and Naveen Yadav, DCC Presidents Deepak John and Motha Rohith, and



TPCC Election Commission Coordination Committee Chairman Rajesh. Addressing the media after the meeting, Minister Ponnamm Prabhakar highlighted that the voter revision process has been moving at a sluggish pace across the state.

Amaravati, July 14: Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has criticized the fragmentation of systems in AP between 2019-2024. He said that the state was destroyed in those five years. Speaking at a meeting of ministers, secretaries and

HODs on Tuesday, the CM said... We have worked together for the past two years... We have given meaning to welfare, development and good governance. He commended the government machinery for effectively implementing the government's ideas.

He expressed the view that while the desired changes had been achieved to some extent, there was still a need for improvement in several other areas. The Chief Minister advised every government department to periodically assess the results they



have achieved. He mentioned that a Collectors' conference is held every three months and that the GSDP is being analyzed. He stated that the 'Swarnandhra 2047' vision has been formulated in alignment with the path of 'Viksit Bharat 2047'. He revealed that targets for per capita income and GSDP have been set. He also noted that 19 SIPB meetings and 57 Cabinet meetings have been conducted so

far. It was stated that entrepreneurs had lost confidence in Andhra Pradesh during the previous administration, but that situation has since been restored, and the state has once again emerged as a most preferred destination. Large-scale investments are flowing into the state, which will lead to widespread employment opportunities.

Jagan has no moral right to speak about fishermen : Minister Atchanna

Amaravati, July 14 : Andhra Pradesh Agriculture Minister Kinjarapu Atchanna on Tuesday lashed out at YCP chief Jagan Mohan Reddy following his visit to Visakhapatnam. Minister Atchanna asserted that Jagan has no moral right to speak about fishermen, noting that a total of 270 fishermen lost their lives due to natural calamities during the five-year YCP regime. However, he stated that they would not speak so irresponsibly as to claim that Jagan himself killed them. Minister Atchanna questioned Jagan as to why he had not visited even



a single one of the 270 families affected by the deaths that occurred back then. Speaking on this occasion, Minister Atchanna said, "Jagan Mohan Reddy, the leader of the 'Axe Party,' visited Visakhapatnam today. The son of your former minister, Seediri Appalaraju, struck a person with his vehicle.

Jagan blames Naidu govt for death of six fishermen, demands Rs 1 crore compensation

Visakhapatnam, July 14 : Former Chief Minister and YSR Congress Party President Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy has squarely blamed negligence of Andhra Pradesh's coalition government led by Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu for the death of six fishermen and demanded compensation of Rs 1 crore each for the affected families. Speaking to the media here on Tuesday after consoling the families of the deceased and interacting with the lone survivor of the tragedy, Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy said that the boat carrying seven fishermen who went into the sea for fishing capsized just 10 miles away from Gangavaram Port and not a single official responded despite repeated pleas from the affected families. After the capsizing, the lone survivor, Chinna, swam to safety and was rescued by a Chinese boat. The family members repeatedly called and sent SOS messages to the Collector and other officials, but there was no response. Had there been one, the other fishermen could have been rescued. All seven



persons had set sail, but only one returned with great difficulty, and the government did not respond in the way it should have, he said. The former CM stated that as the blame lies entirely with the gov-

ernment, it should take responsibility and pay Rs 1 crore each to all the affected families. He also said that if the coalition government fails to pay Rs 1 crore compensation.



Left student unions lay siege to secretariat over fee reimbursement dues

Hyderabad, July 14 : Tension prevailed near the Telangana Secretariat on Tuesday as Left-affiliated student unions staged a "Chalo Secretariat" protest demanding the immediate release of pending fee reimbursement and scholarship arrears. Police erected barricades to stop

the march, leading to heated confrontations with protesters. Several student leaders and activists were detained, while some students reportedly sustained minor injuries during the scuffle. Preventive arrests were also carried out in several districts to curb participation in the protest.

Leaders of AISF, SFI, AIFDS, PDSU, AISB and AIPSU alleged that lakhs of economically weaker students were on the verge of discontinuing their education due to delayed fee reimbursements and scholarships. They further alleged that educational institutions were with-

holding certificates over unpaid fees while accusing the state government of failing to address students' concerns.

The student leaders demanded the immediate release of Rs.11,000 crore in pending reimbursements and scholarships, warning that they would intensify statewide protests if the government failed to clear the dues. Those detained during the protest were later shifted to various police stations.



Site Inspection for CWC Warehouse Construction

District Collector and Officials Inspect Site within Sircilla Municipal Limits

Rajanna Sircilla, July 14 : District Collector Garima Agrawal inspected a site for the construction of a Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC) warehouse. On Tuesday, District Collector Garima Agrawal, accompanied by Additional Collector Gaddam Nagesh, CWC Regional Manager Vishnuvardhan, and revenue officials, conducted a field inspection at Peddur—

within the Sircilla municipal limits and near the District Indira Mahila Shakti Bhavan—to assess the location for the proposed CWC warehouse. She inquired about the extent of land available and sought details regarding the planned acreage and storage capacity of the facility. Sircilla RDO Sridhar Babu, Tahsildar Mahesh, CWC officials, and others participated in the program.



Measles can trigger fatal brain disorder years later, says Hyd Research Institute

Hyderabad, July 14 : Hyderabad-based Resplce Autism Research Foundation & Institute has launched a research initiative to better understand and prevent Subacute Sclerosing Panencephalitis (SSPE), a rare, progressive and fatal neurological complication of Measles that has no cure to date. Founder Chairman Dr Chandrashekhar Thodupunuri said the institute will use a multi-omics approach to identify why only a small number of children develop SSPE and explore strategies for early prediction and prevention. As part of the initiative, a free medical camp for children with a history of measles, suspected SSPE, vaccine reactions or developmental regression will be held on August 9 at the institute in Manikonda, Hyderabad.



Mandaviya announces Ramagundam ESI hospital, Nacharam nursing college by next year

Hyderabad, July 14 : Union Minister for Labour and Employment Mansukh Mandaviya has announced that the 100-bed ESI Hospital at Ramagundam and the ESI Nursing College at Nacharam will be made operational by next year. Responding positively to a request made by Minister for Labour, Employment and Mines Dr. G. Vivek Venkatswamy, and Peddapalli MP G. Vamshi Krishna, the Union Minister assured that both prestigious projects

would be completed on priority and brought into service at the earliest. The announcement was made after Union Minister Mansukh Mandaviya and Vivek Venkatswamy jointly inaugurated the new Outpatient Department (OPD) Block at the ESIC Hospital, Sanathnagar.

CS reviews arrangements for BRICS anti-corruption meet in Hyderabad

Hyderabad, July 14 : Chief Secretary Sanjay Jaju on Tuesday reviewed the arrangements being made for the 2nd BRICS Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting, which is scheduled to be held in Hyderabad on August 4 and 5. The review meeting, held at the Secretariat, focused on ensuring seamless coordination among various departments for the successful conduct of the prestigious international event. The meeting was attended by

senior officials of the State government and representatives of the Government of India. The 2nd BRICS Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting will bring together around 40 international delegates from the 11 BRICS member countries. In addition, nearly 40 senior officials from the government of India will also participate in the deliberations. During the meeting, Joint Secretary, Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT), Government of India, Sushil Kumar Patel, gave a

detailed presentation on the event and outlined the support required from the State government. He requested assistance in areas such as security arrangements, sanitation, health and emergency medical services, transportation, protocol, accommodation, venue management and other logistical requirements to ensure the smooth conduct of the meeting. Reviewing the preparations, Chief Secretary Sanjay Jaju directed all the concerned departments to work in close coordination and



make comprehensive arrangements well in advance. He instructed officials to ensure fool-proof security, efficient transport and traffic management, high standards of sanitation and cleanliness, adequate medical facilities, uninterrupted civic services and seamless coordination among all agencies involved.

Telangana CM Reddy seeks Centre's nod to begin work on Regional Ring Road's northern section

Hyderabad, July 14 : Telangana Chief Minister, Revanth Reddy, on Tuesday requested Union Minister for Road Transport, Nitin Gadkari, to secure Union Cabinet approval to commence work on the northern section of the Regional Ring Road (RRR), noting that 95 per cent of the land acquisition has already been

completed. Chief Minister Reddy met Union Minister Gadkari at his residence in Delhi and also urged him to grant the necessary approvals for the Southern Section of the RRR. CM Reddy stated that if work on both sections of the RRR begins simultaneously, construction would be completed faster and costs reduced.



CM Reddy further appealed to Union Minister Gadkari to immediately grant approvals for the Greenfield Highway connecting Hyderabad to Andhra Pradesh's

capital Amaravati, a project mandated by the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act.

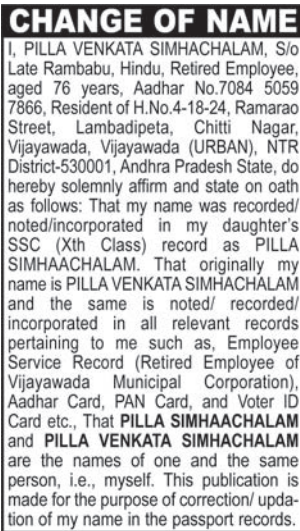

India, Australia deepen strategic partnership with new defence, energy, technology agreements

Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Australian PM Anthony Albanese on Friday issued a joint statement after their Annual Leaders' Summit in Melbourne, announcing a series of landmark agreements across defence, security, energy, critical minerals, cyber technologies and trade that further deepen the India-Australia Comprehensive Strategic Partnership. The two leaders also unveiled a Joint Declaration on Defence and Security Cooperation and reaffirmed their shared commitment to strengthening collaboration in the Indo-Pacific, while agreeing to accelerate negotiations on a Comprehensive Economic Cooperation Agreement (CECA) and a bilateral investment treaty. Welcoming Prime Minister Modi, Albanese described India as one of Australia's closest partners and underscored the growing importance of bilateral ties. "Prime Minister Modi, you are a true friend of Australia, and it has been a great honour to host you for our Annual Leaders Summit today," Albanese said. Highlighting the trajectory of bilateral relations, he added, "Australia and India are close partners and even closer friends. Six years into our comprehensive strategic partnership, Australia's relationship with India has never been more consequential than it is today. Our partnership has never been stronger." Albanese said the two sides had expanded cooperation across multiple sectors through "new landmark agreements". "Prime Minister Modi and I have released a Joint Declaration on Defence and Security Cooperation to deepen our practical partnership. Australia values India as a top-tier security partner, and the Declaration reflects our shared commitment to a peaceful, stable and prosperous Indo-Pacific region," he said. He further announced that both countries had endorsed a Joint Maritime Security Collaboration Roadmap and agreed to establish a new Australia-India Partnership on Cyber, Critical Technologies and Supply Chains. On energy cooperation, Albanese confirmed the signing of an administrative arrangement to operationalise uranium exports to India under the 2015 Australia-India Nuclear Cooperation Agreement. "Today we can confirm the signing of the administrative arrangement to enable uranium exports to India for peaceful purposes under the 2015 Australia-India Nuclear Cooperation Agreement," he said, adding that the move would support India's clean energy transition while creating opportunities for Australia's resources sector. The Australian Prime Minister also announced continued cooperation on critical minerals, support for India's Gaganyaan human spaceflight programme through a temporary space tracking terminal on the Cocos (Keeling) Islands, and progress on cultural repatriation initiatives between the two countries. Addressing the joint media statement, Prime Minister Modi thanked Albanese for his leadership in strengthening bilateral ties. "I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to my friend, Prime Minister Albanese, for the grand welcome and warm hospitality extended to me and my delegation in Melbourne. Thanks to his personal efforts and to his commitment, India-Australia relations have attained new heights and acquired breadth and depth as well," PM Modi said. The Prime Minister noted that the India-Australia Comprehensive Strategic Partnership had witnessed "unprecedented progress" over the past few years. "The Economic Cooperation and Trade Agreement signed in 2022 has consistently broadened the scope of our trade and investment. We have now decided to work at a fast pace on a Comprehensive Economic Cooperation Agreement - that is CECA. An agreement that will be balanced, ambitious and win-win for both countries," he said. PM Modi also highlighted the importance of the newly signed nuclear energy agreement. "We have signed an important agreement today on nuclear energy. This will pave the way for uranium supplies from Australia to India and give our clean energy objectives fresh momentum," he said. Emphasising cooperation in emerging technologies and critical minerals, PM Modi announced that both countries had launched the Australia-India Partnership on Advanced Cyber and Critical Technologies and Supply Chains.

Omkareshwar's 'Statue of Oneness' is structurally safe: MP govt

Bhopal, July 14 : The Madhya Pradesh government on Tuesday said the 108-foot-tall 'Statue of Oneness' dedicated to Adi Shankaracharya at Omkareshwar is structurally safe and built as per international engineering standards. The clarification comes amid a controversy after the Opposition Congress alleged that cracks had appeared in the statue and demanded an independent technical inspection. In a statement, chief engineer and project director of 'Ekatma Dham' Rajiv Srivastava said the multi-metal statue, installed in 2023, is "completely safe, robust and structurally strong". He said the project was executed by the Madhya Pradesh State Tourism Development Corporation through Larsen & Toubro (L&T), while JTQ carried out the casting work. Singapore-based Meinhardt was the project management consultant and C.P. Kukreja Associates was the design consultant. Srivastava said IIT Madras and IIT Delhi provided technical support for the project. IIT Madras conducted seismic studies, while IIT Delhi assessed the statue's design life at more than 500 years. "The statue has been designed and constructed following the highest engineering standards. All technical studies have confirmed its structural stability," he said. According to the government, the monument was designed to meet safety standards applicable to Seismic Zone-IV, even though Omkareshwar falls under Seismic Zone-III. A wind tunnel study by Germany-based Werner Sobek

AG also found the structure capable of withstanding wind speeds of up to 169 kmph. The government said a structural analysis using ETABS software showed that the monument's stress ratio was well within the permissible limit, indicating a high level of safety. Srivastava said the pedestal and the main structural framework of the statue remain firmly anchored and there is no concern regarding



its stability. The statement assumes significance as the Congress recently alleged that cracks had developed in the statue and questioned the quality of its construction. The party has sought an independent technical audit, while the BJP government has dismissed the allegations, maintaining that the monument is safe and meets all prescribed engineering standards.

India gifts laptops, books and video conference equipment to Uganda



Kampala, July 14 : The Government of India on Tuesday gifted video conference equipment, laptops and books to Uganda People's Defence Force (UPDF)'s premier training centres. "As part of its commitment to supporting capacity building and enhancing defence partnership with Uganda, Government of India gifted video conference equipment, laptops and books to UPDF's premier training centres in Kimaka and Nakasongola to improve overall learning experience."

Hamas holds 'crucial' talks in Cairo on Gaza ceasefire's second phase: Source

Cairo, July 14 : A Hamas delegation held "crucial" talks in Cairo on Tuesday with Egyptian officials on arrangements for implementing the second phase of the Gaza ceasefire agreement, an Egyptian security source told media. The delegation discussed preparations for the next phase of the Gaza peace plan, the source said on condition of anonymity. Hamas reaffirmed its readiness to hand over the Gaza Strip to the National Committee for the Administration of Gaza, paving the way for the second phase of the plan, which includes a full Israeli military withdrawal from Gaza, the source said. The group also agreed to place its weapons under the committee's custody and expressed willingness to facilitate the work of the peace-keeping force and the national committee, the source



added. The mediators have received a proposal from the US-led "Board of Peace" to establish a pilot buffer zone in the southern Gaza city of Rafah to accommodate tens of thousands of residents after security screening conducted by the committee, according to the source. The source said all relevant parties are coordinating closely to implement the plan. The talks came after Hamas announced on Monday the dissolution of the Government Emergency Committee in Gaza and the transfer of the administration of the Gaza Strip to the national committee.



IMF backs free trade despite tariffs

Washington, July 14 : The International Monetary Fund (IMF) on Tuesday reaffirmed its support for free trade and open markets despite growing tariff barriers and rising economic nationalism, saying global trade remains essential for raising living standards and reducing poverty, even as it acknowledged that the gains from globalisation have not been shared equally. Speaking at the IMF's regular press briefing, Julie Kozack, Director of the IMF's Communications Department, said the Fund's long-standing position in favour of open markets remains unchanged despite an increasingly protectionist global trading environment.

Gujarat's Great Indian Bustard chick survives critical first 40 days under conservation project

Bhuj, July 14 : Gujarat has recorded a significant milestone in its efforts to conserve the critically endangered Great Indian Bustard (GIB), with a chick born under the state's 'Jump Start' conservation project at Naliya in Kutch district completing the first 40 days of its life. The chick, which hatched on May 21 under the second phase of the 'Jump Start' project, has survived what wildlife experts consider the most vulnerable period of its early life. The achievement marks an important step in the conservation of one of the world's most threatened bird species. State Forest and Environment Minister Arjun Modhwadia said the development represents a notable achievement in Gujarat's wildlife conservation efforts. "This is a matter of immense joy and pride for Gujarat. The success of this special campaign undertaken for the conservation of the Great Indian



Bustard is the result of the relentless hard work and dedication of our scientists, wildlife enthusiasts and Forest Department officials. The first 40 days of a chick's life are extremely delicate, and crossing this important milestone brings new hope for the bird's bright future," Modhwadia said. The minister said the success had been achieved under the guidance of Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel and highlighted the importance of protecting endangered species to maintain ecological balance. "Protecting such endangered species

is essential to maintaining the balance between humanity and nature. This achievement will mark a new milestone in India's journey towards biodiversity conservation. This success further strengthens the Gujarat government's commitment to wildlife conservation and to preserving our natural heritage for future generations," he added. According to the state government, the 'Jump Start' project involves protecting Great Indian Bustard eggs in their natural habitat before scientifically rearing the chicks through a foster-mothering programme at a dedicated conservation facility. Officials described the process as technically complex and requiring continuous scientific intervention during the chick's early stages of life. The Forest Department said the chick at Naliya is being monitored around the clock by a team of officials and wildlife experts.

Indian Navy assumes key role at world's largest maritime warfare exercise



Honolulu, July 14 : Indian Navy has assumed the role of Deputy Commander Task Force for Theatre-level Anti-Submarine Warfare during the Rim of the Pacific (RIMPAC) 2026 maritime warfare exercise. "As the sea phase of Exercise RIMPAC2026 commences, Indian Navy's P-8I LRM aircraft and contingent of participating personnel continued active engagement with partner navies through mission planning, technical preparations, operational briefings and professional exchanges," the spokesperson of the Indian Navy wrote on X. "This is the first time that Indian Navy is discharging the role of Deputy Commander Task Force for Theatre-level Anti-Submarine Warfare during the exercise," it added. The aircraft and contingent arrived in Hawaii earlier this month.

US lawmakers seek China link in Tiananmen museum attack in California

Washington, July 14 : Two senior Republican lawmakers have urged the US Justice Department and FBI to investigate whether China was linked to the vandalism of a Tiananmen Square memorial museum in California. Representatives Chris Smith of New Jersey and John Moolenaar of Michigan made the request in a letter to Acting Attorney General Todd Blanche. Smith co-chairs the Congressional-Executive Commission on China, while

Moolenaar chairs the House Select Committee on China. Unknown individuals broke into the June Fourth Massacre Memorial Museum in El Monte shortly before the 37th anniversary of the June 4, 1989, crackdown, according to public reporting cited by the lawmakers. The intruders spray-painted walls and exhibits, damaged property and interfered with the museum’s surveillance system. “The Museum preserves the irrefutable, brutal truth about the Tiananmen Massacre, the same

truth that the CCP has spent nearly four decades actively denying and trying to bury,” Smith said. “That is why the DOJ must treat this attack with the seriousness it deserves and determine whether it was more than ordinary vandalism,” he said. The lawmakers asked the Justice Department, including the FBI’s Los Angeles Field Office and National Security Division, to work with local authorities. They want investigators to determine whether the attack was connected to China,

the Chinese Communist Party or people acting in sympathy with Beijing’s campaign to silence its critics abroad. “If this attack was planned, supported, or carried out by anyone acting on behalf of the Chinese Communist Party, it would be an attack on free speech, historical memory, and the safety of Chinese democracy advocates living in the United States,” Smith said. Moolenaar said the Chinese Communist Party was constantly seeking to silence its critics in the United States through



transnational repression. “The DOJ and FBI should investigate the vandalism at the June 4 Massacre Memorial Museum to protect the inalienable rights of the Chinese diaspora seeking freedom in the United States, as well as patriotic Chinese Americans who dare to speak out against the

CCP,” he said. The lawmakers cited what they called a troubling pattern of incidents in California. These included the destruction of sculptures and surveillance targeting linked to Liberty Sculpture Park and dissident artist Chen Weiming.

Two more provinces affected as DR Congo Ebola outbreak remains 'very active': Health Minister

Kinshasa, July 14 : The ongoing Ebola outbreak in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) has now affected the provinces of Tshopo and Haut-Uele, as the epidemic remains in a “very active” phase, Health Minister Roger Kamba said on Tuesday. Health authorities have observed patients moving from affected areas to-

ward Kisangani, the capital of Tshopo Province, and the Wamba area in Haut-Uele Province, bringing the two provinces into the scope of the outbreak response, Kamba said in Bunia, the provincial capital of Ituri, which is the epicentre of the outbreak. “We are still in an active, even very active, phase of the disease,” Kamba said while reviewing the national response.



Given the high population density, strong mobility, and local factors complicating community engagement in affected areas, he

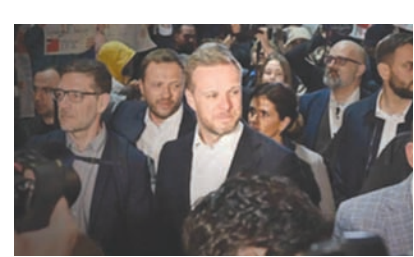
said it was still impossible to determine when the outbreak would reach its peak. Kamba made the comments in a video

provided Thursday by the health ministry during his visit to Bunia, capital of the eastern Ituri Province, Xinhua news agency reported. According to Kamba, Ituri remains in an acute growth phase of the outbreak, while North Kivu Province is also still seeing an active increase in cases. The spread to additional areas, he said, underscores the need to strengthen surveillance at entry points and checkpoints, and to limit high-risk movements as much as possible. He added that the outbreak could soon be declared over in South

Kivu Province, which has reported no new cases since May 26, according to a situation report released Wednesday. The death toll in DRC due to the outbreak has reached 600, with 1,759 confirmed cases reported, according to the country’s health authorities. A total of 750 patients are currently in isolation or hospitalisation, with an overall bed occupancy rate of 94 per cent, health authorities said in an update released late Wednesday.

Lithuanian Foreign Minister quits as chairman of ruling party

Vilnius, July 14 : Lithuanian Foreign Minister Gabrielius Landsbergis announced on Tuesday that he is stepping down as chairman of the ruling Homeland Union-Lithuanian Christian Democrats (TS-LKD) and giving up his seat in the newly elected parliament. "I'm making the decision to take a break from my political career. I'm handing over my mandate to my colleague next in line," Landsbergis said at a post-election press conference.



Graft report rekindles fresh concerns over China-aided projects in Nepal



Kathmandu/New Delhi, July 14 : Even before a new government officially assumes office in Nepal, certain contentious issues coming to the public domain recently are raising serious questions over the previous government's economic and ideological connections with China. Though former Prime Minister K.P. Sharma Oli faced strong political opposition within, and diplomatic resistance outside over security issues, he included several ambitious projects under Beijing's Belt and Road Initiative (BRI).

Mizoram: Contraband valued at Rs 4.21 crore seized, 9 held

Aizawl, July 14 : The Mizoram Police, in a series of coordinated operations over the past two days, seized drugs, Myanmar-origin areca nuts (betel nuts) and other contraband worth around Rs 4.21 crore and arrested nine drug peddlers and smugglers, including two Myanmar nationals, officials said on Tuesday. A police official said that the Champhai Police Special Task Force intercepted a Bolero vehicle on suspicion while it was proceeding towards Champhai, which borders Myanmar. The vehicle was driven by Rajiv Hussein Laskar (26) and accompanied by Jinuk Uddin Laskar (30), both residents of Silchar in Assam's Cachar district. A search of the vehicle led to the recovery of nine bags containing approximately 210 kg of suspected dehydrated manta ray/mobula gill plates, concealed inside. The seized consignment has an estimated international black-market value of Rs 2.30 crore and

is believed to be among the largest of its kind in Mizoram. As the recovered items are suspected to have been obtained from species protected under wildlife laws, the seized contraband, the vehicle and the two accused were handed over to the Divisional Forest Officer, Champhai Forest Division, for scientific examination and further legal action under the relevant provisions of law. In another operation, a joint team of the Aizawl District Special Branch (DSB) and the Assam Rifles seized 1.955 kg of highly addictive methamphetamine, valued at approximately Rs 1.60 crore, from the possession of Marcus Lalvenpuia (19), a resident of Mamit district. In two other separate operations, heroin worth around Rs 15 lakh was seized from Zokhawthar in Champhai district, and two Myanmar nationals were arrested in connection with the case.

Vijayan rebuts CM Satheesan on Wayanad tunnel clearance, demands accountability for mudslide, toll rises

Kalpetta (Kerala), July 14 : Kerala's Leader of the Opposition, Pinarayi Vijayan, on Tuesday mounted a sharp attack on Chief Minister V.D. Satheesan over his remarks on the environmental clearance granted to the Wayanad tunnel road project, accusing the government of attempting to create a controversy to divert

attention from administrative lapses that may have contributed to the devastating mudslide at Kalladi. The tunnel project was cleared by Vijayan when he was the Chief Minister and he inaugurated the tunnel construction early this year. Addressing reporters after visiting the disaster site, Vijayan said the Chief Minister's claim that the environmental clearance had been

secured through questionable means was factually incorrect. The clearance, he said, followed a transparent process that began with detailed scientific studies in 2023 and received approvals from both the state and Central governments. He pointed out that the Kerala High Court had dismissed petitions challenging the environmental clearance on December 16, 2025, and



that the Supreme Court subsequently upheld the verdict. Alleging that the clearance was obtained through pressure or manipulation amounted to disregarding judicial findings, he said.

Assam Rifles seize 1,200 detonators in Mizoram, one held

Aizawl, July 14 : Assam Rifles personnel seized 1,200 detonators and arrested an individual in Mizoram's Aizawl district, officials said on Tuesday. A defence spokesman said that in a successful operation, Assam Rifles troops recovered the detonators, used to trigger a larger explosion in a bomb or explosive charge, from the Durtlang area of Aizawl. During the operation, one individual was apprehended, and his vehicle seized. The spokesman said that the operation was launched based on specific intelligence inputs regarding the movement of

explosive materials in the Aizawl area. Acting swiftly on the information, troopers of the Assam Rifles carried out vehicle interception and checking in the suspected area, he said. During the check, the team recovered 1,200 detonators concealed inside the driver's seat of the vehicle. The entire operation was conducted with utmost caution, keeping in view the sensitive nature of the recovered items. The apprehended individual, along with the recovered detonators and vehicle, has been handed over to the Durtlang police station for further investigation and legal proceedings. An Assam Rifles statement said



that the successful recovery once again highlights the unwavering commitment of the Assam Rifles towards maintaining peace, security and stability in Mizoram. Assam Rifles continues to remain vigilant and committed in its efforts to curb illegal activities and ensure safety in the region, it noted. Aizawl district shares inter-district borders with Champhai and Mamit districts, which in turn share unfenced international borders with Myanmar and Bangladesh, respectively.

Sensex jumps over 700 points, Nifty tops 24,160 as IT stocks lead market rally

Mumbai, July 14 : Indian benchmark equity indices opened sharply higher on Tuesday, tracking gains in global markets as a rally in chip stocks boosted investor sentiment, with information technology shares emerging as the biggest gainers. During early trade, the Sensex was trading 701.73 points, or 0.91 per cent, higher at 77,443.55. The Nifty advanced 200.85 points, or 0.84 per cent, to 24,162.25. Commenting on Nifty technical outlook, experts said that the 24,100–24,200 region is expected to act as the immediate resistance. "A sustained breakout above this band would improve market sentiment and could support a recovery towards the 24,400 region," as per the expert. "On the downside, the 23,900 level remains the immediate support, followed by the 23,800 mark.

India hosts half of the world's GCCs, emerges as second-largest hub for enterprise AI talent: CEA

New Delhi, July 14 : India now hosts around half of the world's Global Capability Centres (GCCs) and has emerged as the second-largest base for enterprise artificial intelligence (AI) talent globally, reflecting the country's growing role in innovation, technology and high-value global business operations, Chief Economic Adviser (CEA) V. Anantha Nageswaran said on Tuesday. Addressing the CII GCC Business Summit, Nageswaran said India's GCC ecosystem has undergone a remarkable transformation over the past two decades, evolving from a handful of back-office operations into more than 2,000 centres employing over 2 million professionals. He said employment in the sector is now moving towards 2.3 million, while annual revenues have exceeded \$60 billion and are on track to approach \$100 billion. "India now hosts around half of the world's GCCs. This did not happen by accident; it happened because of our people, because talent is the heart of the matter,"



Nageswaran stated. "These centers first came to India for cost; they stayed for capability," he mentioned. The CEA said GCCs now contribute nearly 2 per cent of India's gross domestic product (GDP) and account for a significant share of new office space developed across major Indian cities. He noted that no other country comes close to India's scale, with around half of the world's GCCs now operating from the country. Explaining the evolution of the sector, Nageswaran said Indian GCCs have moved far beyond their traditional role of providing cost-efficient back-office support. Today, they undertake high-value work across technology, engineering, research, product development, analytics and digital transformation. He said global banks manage risk systems and trading platforms from Mumbai and Bengaluru, automobile manufacturers design vehicles and embedded systems from Chennai and Pune, semiconductor firms carry out chip design in India, pharmaceutical companies conduct clinical analytics.



Groww responds after Zerodha CEO questions its pivot to regular mutual funds

New Delhi, July 14 : Zerodha founder and CEO Nithin Kamath on Tuesday took a swipe at rival platforms on X after Groww, one of India's largest retail brokers by active users, began offering regular mutual funds through its subscription service Groww Prime. In a social media post, Kamath said many platforms that launched direct mutual fund offerings around the time Zerodha introduced its Coin platform have since "disappeared or pivoted to something else." Remaining competitors are "rethinking their choice of offering direct plans," he said, adding that "Zerodha will continue to offer direct mutual funds for free."



Dixon Technologies shares hit 16-month low, down 34 pc

Mumbai, July 14 : Shares of Dixon Technologies continued to slide for the sixth consecutive session on Tuesday, falling another 4 per cent to Rs 11,821. This marked the stock's lowest level since August 2024, as selling pressure remained strong. At the closing bell, the shares were down by Rs 448 or

3.63 per cent to Rs 11,880 on the National Stock Exchange (NSE). The stock has been in a sharp downtrend since late September and has lost around 35 per cent of its value from its peak of Rs 18,471. The decline has largely been driven by concerns that the company's

The shift reflects a broader change in financial planning from fear-driven security to aspiration-driven ambition, blending protection with progress and lifestyle freedom, it said. Family security and health emergencies, once dominant, have slipped down the list. In their place, aspirations such as lifestyle upgrades.

New Delhi, July 14 : Concentrated revenue risk, dependence on government-owned transmission grids and infrastructure, and growth relying on winning highly competitive project bids are key risks for ACME Solar Holdings IPO, a brokerage firm said on Tuesday. The IPO is a mix of fresh issue of up to Rs 2,395 crore

and an offer of sale (OFS) of up to Rs 505 crore. According to a note by Bajaj Broking, the company focuses on the development, construction, ownership, operation, and maintenance of large-scale renewable energy projects. It accomplishes this through its internal engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) division, and operations and maintenance (O&M) team. The company



generates revenue by selling electricity to various clients, including those supported by the Central and state governments. Citing key risks of its business, the brokerage note read: "Concentrated revenue risk: 63.22 per cent of revenue from Andhra Pradesh.

Samsung enables Quick Share to work with Apple's AirDrop

Seoul, July 14 : Samsung Electronics said on Tuesday it has begun supporting compatibility between the Android file-sharing platform Quick Share and Apple's AirDrop, allowing Galaxy S26 smartphone users to exchange photos across different devices. The South Korean tech giant said the update, available to Galaxy S26 series users starting Monday, will enable users to exchange files with iPhones powered by iOS, reports Yonhap news agency. While Quick Share and AirDrop are both based on Bluetooth technology to identify nearby devices and exchange photos, videos, contact numbers and files, they had not supported

interoperability. "AirDrop support will initially be available on the Galaxy S26 series, with expansion to additional devices to be announced at a later date," the company said in a release. The service will be available in other major markets, including the United

States and Europe, starting Wednesday. "We have maximised user convenience by helping Galaxy users communicate seamlessly with users of devices running on other operating systems," an official from the company said.

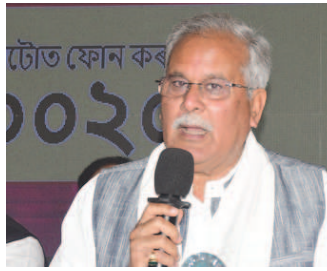

The development comes a day after a heated exchange between Gogoi and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Pijush Hazarika on the floor of the Assembly over the issue of criminal cases and disclosures made in election documents.



Congress will form 'next govt' in Punjab, claims Baghel

Party sources said the Baghel-Channi meeting is expected to take place.

K'taka: BJP objects to mass filling of SIR Enumeration Forms at religious places

Bengaluru, July 14 : BJP National General Secretary and Karnataka in-charge Radhamohan Das Agrawal on Tuesday objected to the alleged mass filling of Special Intensive Revision (SIR) enumeration forms at religious places and locations identified by Congress leaders, calling the practice inappropriate. Addressing a press conference at the BJP's state headquarters, Jagannath Bhavan, in Bengaluru, Agrawal alleged that the Congress was attempting to use the SIR exercise for political purposes.

"Enumeration forms are being filled collectively at religious places and at locations suggested by Congress leaders. This is not the correct procedure," he said.

Agrawal said the BJP had lodged a complaint with the Election Commission alleging that Booth Level Officers (BLOs) were not visiting households as mandated.

"The Election Commission has clearly instructed BLOs to distribute the forms by visiting every household. We have raised this issue with the Commission," he said.

He added that the BJP had conducted meetings and training sessions for its Booth Level Agent-2 (BLA-2) workers to ensure they were prepared for the SIR process.

Criticising the state government, Agrawal alleged that it was not utilising BJP-appointed BLA-2 workers. Responding to another question, he said internal party matters had been



discussed with elected representatives.

Taking a swipe at Karnataka Minister Priyank Kharge, Agrawal said: "No one is paying attention to what Priyank Kharge says. Even his remarks on the issue of kumkum were not appropriate." It can be noted that Karnataka Home Minister Priyank Kharge sparked a political controversy by claiming that "90 per cent of kesar comes from Islamic countries" while questioning the use of a tilak. On reports of cross-voting, Agrawal said appropriate action would be taken against those responsible. "There is continuous coordination between the BJP and the JD(S). We remain in regular touch and discussions are ongoing. A coordination committee has been formed, and BJP state president B.Y. Vijayendra, Leader of the Opposition R. Ashoka, and Union Minister Pralhad Joshi are members of the committee," he said.



Ayodhya seers demand resignation of Ram Temple Trust Treasurer, accuse him of yielding influence

Ayodhya, July 14 : Hindu seers in Ayodhya on Tuesday sought the resignation of Shri Ram Janmbhoomi Teerth Kshetra Trust Treasurer Govind Dev Giri, holding him responsible for the alleged ir-

regularities in the donations made at the Ram Temple and accusing him of "yielding dominance" over Ram Janmbhoomi. Speaking to IANS, Mahant Sitaram Das of Saket Bhavan Temple said: "There has been no statement regarding the resignation submitted by (Trust General Secretary).

Maha govt prioritises long term measures to stabilise onion prices, focuses on processing industry

Mumbai, July 14 : Maharashtra Marketing Minister Jaykumar Rawal said on Tuesday that the state government has implemented various measures to provide relief to onion growers during periods of price drops, with a strong focus on increasing processing industries, expanding storage capacity, and encouraging crop diversification.

He was replying to a discussion initiated by member Vikram Kale regarding the falling onion prices in the state. Key members, including Pravin Darekar, Satej Patil, and Neelam Gorhe, among others, participated in the debate. Minister Rawal noted that international market conditions

had previously hit onion exports, leading to a crash in domestic prices. In response, Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis took the initiative to hold a high-level meeting with the Central government. "Following this meeting, key decisions were made to increase onion procurement targets, implement export incentive measures, and hike procurement prices," the Chief Minister added. Maharashtra leads the country in onion production, contributing a major share to India's total output. Given the consistently rising production, Minister Rawal said that the state government is actively planning to promote onion processing industries, dehydration plants, and onion powder manufacturing units. "To prevent post-



harvest losses, a large number of onion storage structures have already been set up across the state. Moving forward, the state government aims to establish regional onion processing centres through Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs) at both the taluka and district levels," the Minister added. He concluded by noting that during past price crashes, the state government directly credited subsidies into farmers' bank accounts across multiple phases. He assured that current market

rates for onions are satisfactory, and the state government remains committed to continuous measures ensuring stable returns for farmers. Meanwhile, State Cooperation Minister Babasaheb Patil told the Legislative Council during Question Hour that sugar mills across Maharashtra have cleared 99.26 per cent of the Fair and Remunerative Price (FRP) owed to sugarcane farmers.

The remaining outstanding balance of Rs 298 crore will be recovered from defaulting factories along with interest. The issue was raised by member Sadabhau Khot, with follow-up questions raised by members Prajakt Tanpure, Pravin Darekar, Gokul Gite, and Shrikant Bhartiya. Detailing the status of the state's sugar mills, Minister Patil said that 162 mills out of 210 have cleared 100 per cent of their FRP dues, 43 mills have paid between 80 to 99 per cent of their dues.

his campaign. A schedule for the tour will be released later. "Today I am excited to announce my candidacy for the United States Senate to defeat Susan Collins," Shah said in a statement. Shah used his announcement to appeal directly to supporters of



Democratic candidate Graham Platner, whose Senate campaign was suspended earlier this week. "To the movement that supported Graham Platner, my message is this: you have a place in this campaign," Shah said. "That's because this campaign represents the Maine values we all care about: building a state and country where everyone can get ahead, not just the privileged few, respecting and loving our neighbours, and hold-

ing Donald Trump and Susan Collins accountable." He said "establishment politicians have failed us" and argued that "Maine deserves a fighter in this seat, and I will be that fighter." Shah outlined a progressive policy platform, saying he would "fight for Medicare for All because nobody in the wealthiest country on earth should go bankrupt over a medical bill."

India, Vietnam agree to deepen parliamentary friendship

Hanoi, July 14 : India's Ambassador to Vietnam, Tshering W Sherpa on Tuesday, called on Phan Chi Hieu, Chairman of the Vietnam-India Parliamentary Friendship Group (VIPFG) and briefed him on the ongoing initiatives under the India-Vietnam partnership.

Iranian FM discusses regional developments with foreign officials over phone amid renewed US strikes

Tehran, July 14 : Iranian Foreign Minister Seyed Abbas Araghchi discussed the latest regional developments with his Omani and Turkish counterparts as well as Pakistan's army chief in separate phone calls following renewed US strikes on Iran, the Iranian Foreign Ministry said.

In phone calls with Omani Foreign Minister Sayyid Badr bin Hamad Al Busaidi and Turkish Foreign Minister Hakan Fidan, Araghchi discussed the recent developments in the Strait of Hormuz and other issues of common concern, read a ministry statement. They stressed the importance of pursuing diplomacy and maintaining contacts and coordination to address regional issues and prevent further escalation, the statement said. In the phone call with Pakistan's Chief of Army Staff Asim Munir, Araghchi strongly condemned the recent US attacks on Iran, calling them flagrant

violations of the UN Charter and the recently signed Iran-US peace memorandum of understanding (MoU), read another ministry statement. Araghchi warned against any "adventurism" by the US military, reaffirming Iran's determination to defend its territorial integrity, sovereignty and national security, it said. The United States said its forces carried out strikes on multiple targets inside Iran on Wednesday and Thursday in response to Iran's latest attacks on commercial vessels transiting the Strait of Hormuz, saying the operation was intended to degrade Iran's ability to threaten commercial shipping in the strategic waterway.



'There were heroes, so there were villains too': Priyanka Chaturvedi on Jinnah chapter row

New Delhi, July 14 : Shiv Sena-UBT MP Priyanka Chaturvedi, reacting to the Jammu University committee recommending the removal of topics on Pakistan founder Muhammad Ali Jinnah from the curriculum, on Tuesday said that history must reflect both heroes and villains to give a complete understanding of the past. Chaturvedi said that if there are heroes in the pages of history, it is equally important to understand whom they fought against. "If there are heroes, then who did they fight? For that, there are villains too," she remarked. She held that removing such content from textbooks would deprive future generations of a proper understanding of history and the roots of present-

day conflicts. She questioned how students would learn about the reasons behind India's partition and ongoing tensions with Pakistan if such chapters are excluded. "I think on the pages of history, if there are heroes, then who did they fight? For that, there are villains too. The greatest villain for our country was Jinnah, who divided our nation. Before Independence, Jinnah demanded division and asked for Pakistan and Bangladesh," Chaturvedi told IANS. "He created East Pakistan and West Pakistan. What will our future generations know about him? How will they understand why the country was divided? How will people know why there are boundaries and why we continue to hear such statements? The root cause of all this is Jinnah." Emphasising the importance of historical awareness, she said: "If that is removed from textbooks, then how will future generations know about it and understand our conflicts with Pakistan?"



Russia says US actions against Russian reporters violate freedom of information

Moscow, July 14 : Washington's recent actions against Russian journalists violate the right to access information and media pluralism, Russian Foreign Ministry spokesperson Maria Zakharova said Tuesday. A film crew from Russia's Izvestia newspaper, who arrived in Washington to cover the upcoming presidential election, was detained and subjected to hours of interrogation on Tuesday night, resulting in one member being expelled from the country, the Foreign Ministry said in a statement. Zakharova noted that the Russian journalists had notified US authorities of their intentions and received permission before their arrival, adding that this reflects the United States' readiness to use repressive measures against inconvenient information.

After Bangladesh, China in renewed Nepal outreach for further influence in South Asia

New Delhi, July 14 : China now appears to be trying to re-establish its influence in Nepal after a Bangladesh foray, with new promises of economic assistance and infrastructure development. With China's Vice Minister for Commerce Yan Dong's Kathmandu visit this week, the message was unmistakable. Beijing wants deeper economic ties, faster project delivery, and formal safeguards for its investors. This followed Nepal Foreign Minister Shisir Khanal's meeting with his Chinese counterpart Wang Yi in Beijing last month. It marked the Himalayan nation's first diplomatic visit to China since a new government assumed office in Kathmandu earlier this year. Incidentally, Khanal's Beijing trip followed his India visit, underscoring Kathmandu's dual engagement strategy.



Sikhs of America honours diaspora achievers

Washington, July 14 : Sikhs of America honoured Sikh community leaders, lawmakers, philanthropists, entrepreneurs and business figures from the United States and Britain during its annual Vaisakhi Gala Dinner here, recognising their contributions to public service, humanitarian work and Sikh representation. Among the awardees were Virginia Delegate JJ Singh, industrialist and entrepreneur Baldev Singh Kang, Oregon-based philanthropist Sardar Bahadur Singh, Punjab, Minister of Human Rights and Minorities in Punjab province of Pakistan Ramesh Singh Arora and British Sikh MP Tanmanjeet Singh Dhesi. JJ Singh, recognised for becoming the first turbaned Sikh to serve in a state legislature in US history, spoke about the Sikh principles that guided his political campaign. "Work hard, serve others, and believe in something bigger than yourself," Singh said. "Sikh values are American values," he said. "It's about the overlap between the values of our faith and the values of our country." Singh also highlighted legislation he sponsored in Virginia related to protecting places of worship.

Progress on Ukraine was possible, but deal remained distant : US media

Washington, July 14 : US media did not appear to be convinced of a successful Ukrainian peace following the meeting between President Donald Trump and Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky. Most outlets said progress was possible, but a deal remained distant. The Wall Street Journal said the talks at Mar-a-Lago brought "fresh optimism" but no breakthrough.



Fiji introduces new policy to address staff misconduct in schools

Suva, July 14 : Fiji's Education Ministry is developing a comprehensive disciplinary policy to target staff misconduct, shortages and weak accountability. Education Minister Aseri Radrodro said in parliament on Tuesday that the new policy focuses on gaps in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) subjects, remote schools and areas affected by retirements or resignations while improving teacher retention and motivation, Xinhua News Agency reported. The new framework also aims to eliminate previous gaps that led to delays, favoritism and weak accountability, according to Fiji Broadcasting Corporation. Radrodro also outlined changes to the teacher transfer policy to tackle staff shortages and redistribute teachers across schools, divisions and districts. He said teachers can request transfers after serving a set period, with annual windows and formal procedures to ensure fair movements. Earlier in August, Fiji's Cabinet approved the country's first Child Safeguard-



ing Policy, establishing a single national framework to guide ministries, statutory bodies, civil society organisations, and institutions that work with children. The policy sets out responsibilities, procedures, and minimum standards for organisations to follow, ensuring greater accountability and consistency in child protection, reported the Fiji Broadcasting Corporation. The Fiji's Ministry of Women, Children and Social Protection led the development of the framework through nationwide consultations, which included children, families.



Netanyahu, Trump talk over phone, agree to maintain coordination 'on various fronts'

Jerusalem, July 14 : Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu held a phone call with US President Donald Trump, during which the two agreed to continue coordination between their countries "on various fronts," Netanyahu's office said in a statement. During the call on Tuesday, Trump briefed Netanyahu on US actions in the Gulf, the statement said, without elaborating. Xinhua news

agency reported. Meanwhile, Netanyahu raised the "severity" of remarks by Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan and his aides concerning Israel, the statement said, without specifying which remarks Netanyahu was referring to. Israeli officials have recently criticized Erdogan for accusing Israel of undermining US-Iran diplomacy and for calling its government "war-addicted."

Chhattisgarh govt clears key welfare, recruitment measures

Raipur, July 14 : The Chhattisgarh government has decided to invite proposals from banks and financial institutions for providing short-term loans against salaries to government employees. This initiative seeks to address the emergency financial needs of state servants. The Finance Department has been authorised to take further action and finalise the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with eligible institutions. In a Cabinet meeting held on Tuesday at Mahanadi Bhawan, Mantralaya, Chief Minister Vishnu Deo Sai presided over a series of impactful decisions aimed at strengthening financial support and inclusive governance across Chhattisgarh. In a landmark

move for disability welfare, the Cabinet approved the refund of Rs 24.50 crore to the National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation (NHFDC). This amount represents outstanding loans disbursed to persons with disabilities for self-employment and education at a concessional interest rate of 3 per cent. The decision underscores the government's commitment to empowering differently-abled citizens. Further, the Cabinet granted a one-time relaxation in the School Education Department's Recruitment and Promotion Rules, 2019, to facilitate direct recruitment of 100 Special educators.



Akhilesh Yadav questions SIT probe of Ram Temple theft, UP Ministers hits back

New Delhi, July 14 : Samajwadi Party (SP) chief Akhilesh Yadav on Tuesday questioned the functioning of the Special Investigation Team (SIT) into the alleged embezzlement of donations made at Ayodhya's Ram Temple, asking for a probe into the call detail records of the accused and seeking accountability of the temple trust's senior offi-

cials. However, the Uttar Pradesh Ministers hit back, saying that Akhilesh Yadav should first seek blessings at the Ram Temple before making such statements. Taking to X, the SP chief asked: "What kind of restriction is this where the police are opening the door to welcome the accused? How can someone whose name isn't in the interim report be in the final one?" In a reference to the

Malian army says about 100 terrorists neutralised in northern operations

Dakar, July 14 : The Malian forces have neutralised about 100 terrorists during operations carried out on Tuesday in the areas of Anefis and Tabrichat in northern Mali, authorities said on Tuesday. In a statement, the General Staff of the Armed Forces said the Malian Armed Forces, in coordination with their partners, continued operations against armed terrorist groups it described as affiliated with the Group for the Support of Islam and Muslims and the Azawad Liberation Front. According to the statement, the operations involved 13 airstrikes,

destroying six combat vehicles and one pickup truck, Xinhua news agency reported. The general staff reaffirmed the army's determination to continue operations against armed terrorist groups across the national territory. The Malian army said on Tuesday that more than 200 terrorists were neutralised during coordinated air and ground operations carried out in Anefis in the country's northern Kidal region. According to a statement issued by the General Staff of the Armed Forces, Monday's operations involved 35 airstrikes. The provisional toll also included five armoured vehicles, around 20



pickup trucks and about 100 motorcycles destroyed. The army said operations by the Malian Armed Forces and their partners were continuing in Anefis, reaffirming its determination to pursue actions against armed terrorist groups until the set objectives are achieved.

The operations came after attacks on July 4 targeting several localities in Mali, including Aguelhok, Anefis, Gao, Sévaré, and Kenioroba. The Malian army said at the time that it had repelled the attacks. Mali has faced a volatile security situation for years.



Unauthorised construction row: Karnataka BJP asks if state is being governed by Keralites

Bengaluru, July 14 : Responding to the controversy surrounding the removal of unauthorised constructions in the Kogilu locality near Yelahanka in Bengaluru, the Karnataka BJP has chided the Congress-led government, questioning whether the state is being governed by Kannadigas or Keralites. Meanwhile, a delegation from the State Human Rights Commission (SHRC), along with Deputy Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar, is visiting the site. The issue came into focus after Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan alleged that the Karnataka government was adopting a 'bulldozer model', similar to Uttar Pradesh, to evict Muslims in parts of Bengaluru. BJP State General Secretary and MLA V. Sunil Kumar said on Monday that, "While the Chief Minister Siddaramaiah and Deputy Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar are drowned and distracted in the confusion over the transfer of power.



Bangladesh: Six more children die in 24 hours with measles symptoms

Dhaka, July 14 : Six more children died from symptoms similar to measles in Bangladesh in 24 hours till 8 a.m. on Tuesday, bringing the death toll to 459, as the country grapples with a worsening health crisis, according to local media reports. One death was confirmed as measles-related by the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), while the remaining five were classified as suspected, the United News of Bangladesh (UNB) noted in a report. With this, the confirmed number of deaths from measles has reached 75, while the suspected deaths are now at 384. In the 24 hours, a total of 1,274 suspected measles cases were recorded, bringing the total cases to 57,846 during the period, the report said according to the DGHS data. "During the last 24 hours, 243 new confirmed cases of measles were reported, which brought the total number of confirmed infections to 7,767," the report added. 42,092 suspected measles patients were hospitalised since

March 15, of which 37,744 have recovered. On Tuesday, at least 12 more children died of measles and measles-like symptoms in Bangladesh. Among the 12 deaths, four were confirmed measles cases, while the remaining eight children died with symptoms of the disease, Bangladesh's leading newspaper, The Daily Star, reported. Amid the rapid spread of the infection, health experts have called on the Bangladesh government to prioritise the ongoing measles vaccination campaign and set up "fever corners" at local health complexes to facilitate early detection of diseases such as measles and pneumonia. The appeal was made during a joint press conference organised by the Bangladesh Lung Foundation and the Chest and Heart Association of Bangladesh in Dhaka, the report noted. On Wednesday, a group of protesters under the banner of 'Socheton Nagorik Samaj' reportedly formed a human chain in Dhaka's Dhanmondi 27 area.

NCP factions to contest Pune civic body polls together but on separate symbols



Pune, July 14 : In a significant political development, NCP-SP legislator Rohit Pawar on Tuesday announced that the two rival factions of the Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) will contest the upcoming Pune and Pimpri-Chinchwad municipal elections together. The local-level understanding marks a departure from the 2024 Lok Sabha and Assembly elections, in which the two factions had contested against each other. Rohit Pawar's announcement came a day after NCP chief and Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar, during a campaign rally, said that his faction and the Sharad Pawar-led NCP would jointly contest the Pimpri-Chinchwad Municipal Corporation (PCMC) elections. Speaking to reporters, Rohit Pawar said the decision was taken in keeping with the "sentiments and wishes of local party workers".

Mongolia, Kazakhstan upgrade ties to strategic partnership

Ulan Bator, July 14 : Mongolia and Kazakhstan announced on Tuesday the establishment of a strategic partnership, marking a significant step in strengthening bilateral relations. According to the Mongolian presidential press office, Mongolian President Ukhnaa Khurelsukh and his visiting Kazakh counterpart Kassym-Jomart Tokayev emphasised that deepening ties will play an essential role in promoting peace and ensuring sustainable development.



Former Bengal minister Manas Bhunia questioned in cash-for-job scam

Kolkata, July 14 : Former West Bengal minister Manas Bhunia on Tuesday appeared at Sabang police station in

West Midnapore district after receiving a summons for questioning in connection with an alleged cash-for-job scam. According to the police, he was

questioned for about three hours at the police station. Manas Bhunia, however, did not make any comments after leaving the police station. He has been ac-

cused of taking several lakh rupees on the pretext of procuring jobs in the Irrigation Department while he was the minister.



UN relief chief calls for efforts to contain Ebola in Congo

United Nations, July 14 : UN Under-Secretary-General for Humanitarian Affairs and Emergency Relief Coordinator Tom Fletcher called for urgent action to contain Ebola in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and the region. "We need to move faster to break the back of Ebola in the Democratic Republic of the Congo," said Fletcher in a state-

ment on Tuesday. "Ituri province remains the centre of the outbreak, but the virus is spreading across other provinces where conflict and the constant movement of people increase the risk of further transmission." Since the outbreak was declared on May 15, more than 1,700 people have been infected and 600 have died in the DRC.

Concerns mount over excessive police brutality in Pok amid escalating unrest

Islamabad July 14 : As the unrest in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK), which has left dozens dead so far, continues to intensify, the Joint Awami Action Committee (JAAC) alleged that Pakistani police brutality, excessive use of force, arbitrary arrests, intimidation, unlawful raids, and violations of fundamental rights have become increasingly widespread in the region. The group said that these incidents have left countless families traumatised and raise serious concerns about the rule of law and the protection of basic human rights in the occupied territory.



In a video, shared by JAAC, a resident of PoK and medical doctor Masood Khalid recounted the police raid on his home and harassment he and his family allegedly endured. "After this video gets shared, I'm certain that they will kill me. My name is Dr. Masood Khalid, and

I'm the victim of police brutality," said Khalid. Narrating the incident, he said, "On the midnight of 7th July, 2026, at around 12:30 AM, while I was sleeping with my wife and my three children, approximately 35-40 people in police uniform with their faces covered with

masks jumped over the walls of my house, and they came to me. They woke me up, and they started beating me. They were slapping me, punching me, hitting me, hitting me with the wooden rods, and kicking me. And I was only asking that I'm a medical doctor; what had I done? "They started abusing me, and they dragged me, and they put me in the back of a pickup truck, and they started beating me again. They were calling bad names to my dead parents. They were abusing me constantly, and I was just asking continuously, 'I'm a medical doctor. What had I done to deserve this?'"

Bangladesh's women face growing vulnerability in economy : Report

Dhaka, July 14 : Women in Bangladesh are becoming increasingly vulnerable in their economic contributions, overshadowed by rising radicalism, social insecurity, and institutional neglect, a report cited on Tuesday. It added that the widespread lawlessness gripping Bangladesh following former Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's removal has had distinctly gendered consequences, threatening decades of progress amid political upheaval and disorder.

"By mid-2025, civil society organisations had recorded more than 200 cases of women vendors being threatened, assaulted, or forced to abandon market stalls. Many have retreated into unpaid domestic roles, reversing years of incremental progress. The story is similar in the informal urban economy," a report in the Sri Lankan newspaper Daily Mirror detailed. "Women street hawkers, domestic workers, and day labourers report higher risks of abuse, non-payment, and violence. Yet their stories rarely reach headlines, drowned out by the larger



political crisis engulfing the country," it added. The report emphasised that microcredit schemes, many pioneered by Bangladesh's Chief Advisor to the interim govern-

ment, Muhammad Yunus, through Grameen Bank, once served as a vital bridge for rural women to engage in the economy. Yet, it said, under the Yunus-led interim government in 2024-25, these

mechanisms have withered. "Minority women face the harshest conditions.

Former Malaysian PM ordered to enter his defence in money laundering case

Kuala Lumpur, July 14 : Former Malaysian Prime Minister Najib Razak has been ordered to enter his defence against 25 charges of abuse of power and money laundering involving state investment fund 1Malaysia Development Berhad (1MDB) on Tuesday. The High Court has called on Najib to enter his defence on four charges of power abuse and 21 charges of money laundering involving 2.28 billion ringgit (\$20 million US dollars) after Justice Collin Lawrence Sequerah said it had conducted a maximum evaluation and found the prosecution had proven prima facie in its case against the former prime minister. The 1MDB trial now has 97 hearing dates scheduled from December 2 this year until November 2025, with trial dates for every month during this period except for July next year. Najib, 71, has been serving a sentence since August 23, 2022, after being convicted in a separate criminal trial over misappropriating 42 million ringgit from SRC International Sdn Bhd, a former unit of 1MDB.



Indian envoy meets visiting armed forces medical team in Washington

Washington, July 14 : Indian Ambassador to the United States Vinay Kwatra met the visiting officers of the Armed Forces Medical Services of India in Washington during their visit to the United States. In a post on X, Kwatra wrote, "Interacted with Surgeon Vice Admiral Arti Sarin and officers of Armed Forces Medical Services of India who are visiting US for interacting with their counterparts at US INDOPACOM, DHA, Departments of Army, Navy and Air Force. The visit is aimed at enhancing cooperation in military medicine which is an important pillar of strong bilateral defense relationship between India and the US." Despite tensions over trade, security ties between India and the United States have remained strong. In mid-September, Ambassador Kwatra met the US Undersecretary of War for Policy, Elbridge Colby.

South Korea: Special counsel accuses ex-first lady of illegally intervening in state affairs 'behind curtains'

Seoul, July 14 : South Korea's Special counsel Min Joong-ki's team on Tuesday accused former first lady Kim Keon Hee of illegally intervening in state affairs "behind the curtains" as it announced the final results of its investigation. The team raised the accusa-

tion against Kim -- the wife of ousted former South Korean President Yoon Suk Yeol -- in a press briefing, a day after its 180-day investigation into her corruption allegations officially concluded. "The special counsel investigation confirmed the president's spouse engaged in the modern-day sale of public offices,



something expected to be found in history books, and illegally intervened in state affairs behind the curtains, out of the public's sight," assistant special counsel Kim Hyong-kun said.

Bolivian president urges future subnational authorities to unite in tackling crisis

La Paz, July 14 : Bolivian President Rodrigo Paz Pereira called on future subnational authorities to work with the central government to address the country's economic and institutional challenges. Paz Pereira made this appeal after casting his vote in the southern city of Tarija on Tuesday (local time), where elections are being held to choose more than 5,400 officials, including governors, mayors and local legislators for the 2026-2031 term. "We will work with those elected by the will of the people," he said, adding that the elections offer an opportunity to strengthen democracy and encourage citizen participation. He said the current situation requires coordinated efforts among the central government, regional authorities, and the legislature to pursue a common agenda for national recovery, reports Xinhua news agency. The president also highlighted

his administration's progress in economic management, international engagement, security and anti-corruption efforts. More than 7.4 million eligible voters were expected to take part in the elections across more than 33,000 polling stations. Around 250,000 personnel were deployed across the nation to ensure transparency and security in the subnational elections, in which more than 7.4 million citizens were to vote. According to Carlos Alberto Goitia, a member of the Supreme Electoral Tribunal (TSE), the deployment covered all nine departments and 340 municipalities.



China bigger threat than USSR: Ex-US Defence Secy

Washington, July 14 : Former US Defence Secretary Robert Gates has warned that the United States is facing one of the most dangerous periods in its modern history, saying that China poses a broader and more formidable challenge than the Soviet Union ever did. Gates told CBS News on Tuesday that the US was confronting an unprecedented strategic environment shaped by the combined challenge of China and Russia, both nuclear-armed powers increasingly aligned against Washington. "For the first time in our history, we face nuclear-armed adversaries in both Europe and Asia," he said. He warned that China's rapid military modernisation, technological rise and industrial strength had created a strategic challenge unlike any previous American rival. "We have not faced a country that was as technologically advanced as we are, ahead of us in a few areas, behind us in a few areas, pretty much even with us in a few others," Gates said. The former Pentagon Chief said China's global reach now extends well beyond military competition. "So whether it's strategic communications or development assistance or trade or whatever, the Chinese are all over the world dealing with these things," he added. Gates made the remarks after President Donald Trump returned from a summit in Beijing with Chi-



nese President Xi Jinping. Trump had referred to the US and China as a possible "new G2", suggesting the two countries were the world's dominant powers. Gates said China was approaching US power levels but had not yet surpassed America economically or militarily. "I think our military power is greater than theirs, although they're catching up," the former Pentagon Chief said, while noting that China was already ahead in shipbuilding capacity. Much of the interview focused on Taiwan and rising tensions in the Indo-Pacific. Gates urged the Trump administration to move ahead with delayed arms sales to Taiwan, saying Washington needed to reinforce deterrence against Beijing. "I think we should go forward with what we've agreed with Taiwan," he said.



'This is just the beginning': Tendulkar hails landmark Lord's Test as defining moment for women's cricket

New Delhi, July 14 : Former India batting great Sachin Tendulkar described the inaugural women's Test at Lord's as a 'golden moment' for the sport after witnessing India's historic victory over England, saying the occasion marked a significant step in the growth of women's cricket. Tendulkar, who addressed the Harmanpreet Kaur-led side be-

fore the start of the final day's play at the Home of Cricket on Monday, reflected on the significance of the match, India's triumph, and the milestones achieved by Yastika Bhatia and Kranti Gaud at the iconic venue. Having returned to Lord's, where he created countless memories during his playing career, Tendulkar said the staging of the first-ever women's Test at the venue represented a landmark occasion for the game. "Feels nice to be walking back on the green again. A big moment for women's cricket because I remember in 1976, if I'm not mistaken, the first ODI for women was played here."

Vani Kapoor eyes back-to-back titles as strong field assembles for WPGT's 10th leg

Kolar (Karnataka), July 14 : Fresh off her maiden victory of the 2026 season, Vani Kapoor will look to build on her winning momentum when she headlines a competitive field at the 10th leg of the Women's Pro Golf Tour (WPGT), which gets underway at Zion Hills Golf County in Kolar. Vani produced a superb final-round comeback to clinch the ninth leg last week and now returns in search of consecutive titles. She will begin her campaign alongside promising youngster Mannat Brar and amateur Tanishka Prithvi in the opening round. The experienced campaigner is expected to face a stern challenge from an in-form field led by three-time 2026 winner Ridhima Dilawari, Amandeep Drall, who mounted a strong title bid last week, seasoned professional Tvesa Malik and Saanvi Somu, who has been sharpening her game with regular appearances on the Ladies Access Tour in Europe. Former Order of Merit champion Sneha Singh will be hoping to rediscover her best after an inconsistent run of results, while Vidhatri Urs, Anvitha Narender, Seher Atwal and veteran Neha Tripathi will also be targeting a return to the winner's circle.



Jos Buttler joins elite club with 200th ODI appearance for England

Birmingham, July 14 : Jos Buttler added another landmark to his illustrious international career on Tuesday, becoming only the second England cricketer to feature in 200 One-Day Internationals when he took the field against India in the opening match of the three-game series at Edgbaston. The veteran wicketkeeper-batter joined former England captain Eoin Morgan (225 ODIs) in an exclusive club, reaching the milestone 14 years after making his ODI debut against Pakistan in Dubai in February 2012.



Hockey India names squads for inaugural Youth Hockey5s Asian Championship

New Delhi, July 14 : Hockey India on Tuesday announced the Indian Sub-Junior men's and women's squads for the inaugural Youth Hockey5s Asian Championship Muscat 2026, which will be held in Muscat, Oman, from July 20 to 25. The continental tournament will also serve as the Asian quali-

fying event for the inaugural FIH U18 Youth Hockey5s World Cup. Seven teams will compete in each category, with the men's event featuring hosts Oman, India, Pakistan, Iran, Iraq, Saudi Arabia and Bangladesh.



1st ODI: Rohit, Virat return as England elect to bat against India in Birmingham

Birmingham, July 14 : England won the toss and elected to bat against India in the first ODI at the Edgbaston Stadium. England marked two significant milestones as wicketkeeper-batter Jos Buttler became only the second English cricketer to play 200 One-Day Internationals, joining former captain Eoin Morgan (225 ODIs). Meanwhile, fast bowler Josh Tongue made his ODI debut for England, while left-arm spinner Liam Dawson celebrated his 50th international appearance across formats. England captain Harry Brook said his side opted to bat first after winning the toss, believing the surface would favour batting early before offering assistance to the spinners later in the match. Brook said England would approach the ODI series with the same mindset as the T20s by quickly assessing conditions, maintaining clear communication and adapting as the game progresses. He added that having a largely similar squad across the two white-ball formats gives him confidence as captain and reflects the faith the team management has in the group. While acknowledging England's inconsistent ODI performances in recent years, Brook expressed hope that the team could "turn the page" and deliver consistent results, insisting they have the players to do so.

Japan Open: Satwik-Chirag retire hurt again; Sindhu cruises into Rd 2

Tokyo, July 14 : India's campaign at the Japan Open suffered an early setback after star men's doubles pair Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty were forced to retire from their opening-round contest due to Satwik's recurring shoulder injury, while two-time Olympic medallist PV Sindhu made a confident start by advancing to the women's singles second round

on Tuesday. Returning to competition for the first time since withdrawing from the Indonesia Open in June, the world No. 4 duo could not complete their comeback match against Denmark's Daniel Lundgaard and Mads Vestergaard.



'A moment I will remember forever': Sinner reflects after defending Wimbledon crown

London, July 14 : Defending champion Jannik Sinner said winning Wimbledon for a second successive year was a moment he would 'remember forever' after overcoming Alexander Zverev 6-7(7), 7-6(2), 6-3, 6-4 in a high-quality men's singles final at the All England Club on Sunday. The world No. 1 battled back after losing a closely fought opening-set tie-break to retain his crown, claiming his fifth Grand Slam title and extending his remarkable dominance over Zverev with a 10th consecutive victory against the German. "It means a lot to me to win the Wimbledon title on a back-to-back basis. Of course, there was a lot of work behind it, a lot of things we had to improve to stand again in this position," Sinner told Jio Hotstar after lifting the trophy.
