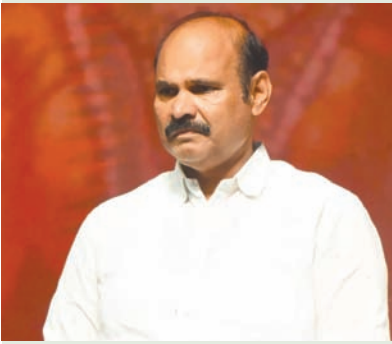

Congress, BJP workers clash near Gandhi Bhavan; Police resort to lathi charge

Hyderabad, July 22 : Political tensions flared in Hyderabad on Wednesday as Congress and BJP workers clashed near Gandhi Bhavan, triggering a major law-and-order situation. The confrontation erupted after BJP workers attempted to march towards Gandhi Bhavan in response to Congress protests held since the morning against the arrest of Leader of the Opposition Rahul Gandhi in New Delhi on Tuesday.





'Will continue agitation if govt doesn't accept adjournment motion': Oppn on paper leak protest

New Delhi, July 22 : The opposition leaders said on Wednesday that the agitation, demanding the resignation of Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan over the NEET paper leak, will continue if the government doesn't accept an adjournment motion in the Parliament. Previously, the Opposition had urged the Union government to accept the motion to facilitate a discussion on the issue. Speaking to reporters outside the Parliament House, Samajwadi Party Chief Akhilesh Yadav said: "Number one, there should be a resignation. Number two, the demands of the students and youth should be addressed. Third, the way the children were treated... if not then it will continue like this, we have to raise our voice." "Paper leaks are not an issue limited to just one examination... there have been more than 150 paper leaks in the country, with more than 20 in Uttar Pradesh alone.

Former Minister Appalaraju arrested

Srikakulam, July 22: Police have arrested YCP leader and former minister Seediri Appalaraju. He was taken into custody on Wednesday from his residence in Kasibugga, Srikakulam district. Appalaraju had attempted to shield his son, Aarav, from a road accident case. His actions were exposed through CCTV footage. The police have already arrested Appalaraju's son, Arav, in connection with this case. Meanwhile, rumors had been circulating since this morning that the police were about to arrest Appalaraju; consequently, a large number of party leaders and activists gathered at his residence. Party leaders, along with family members, attempted to prevent Appalaraju's arrest. However, a large police force already present at the scene thwarted their efforts. Meanwhile, Sidiri Appalaraju filed a petition for anticipatory bail in the Sompeta 6th Additional District and Sessions Court.





152 paper leaks in 10 years: Rahul Gandhi

New Delhi, July 22 : Congress leader Rahul Gandhi alleged that 152 instances of exam paper leaks have come to light over the past decade, noting that not a single case has resulted in the identification of the culprits. Speaking at a press conference held on Wednesday to support the youth protesting against the NEET paper leak, he lashed out at the Central government. He alleged that the entire education system has been compromised by rigging under the current government's administration.



Do not file cases against students : Sonam Wangchuk's letter to the Centre

New Delhi, July 22: Social activist Sonam Wangchuk wrote a letter to Union Ministers J.P. Nadda and Jitendra Singh on Wednesday. In the letter, he appealed against filing cases against the students who participated in the protest. He requested an assurance from the Centre that no cases would be registered against the students, stating clearly that he would call off his fast if such an assurance were given.

Chandrababu Naidu meets PM Modi, invites him for inauguration of Bhogapuram Airport



Amaravati, July 22 : Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu on Wednesday met Prime Minister Narendra Modi in New Delhi and invited him for the inauguration of Bhogapuram International Airport. Accompanied by Civil Aviation Minister K. future of students has been jeopardized by the NEET exam paper leak. Tamil Nadu plans 1,500 new B.Sc. Nursing seats in government medical colleges

Chennai, July 22 : The Tamil Nadu government has initiated steps to significantly expand nursing education by introducing around 1,500 new B.Sc. Nursing seats in government medical colleges across the state from the next academic year. The move is aimed at making professional nursing education more affordable and accessible while addressing the growing demand for trained healthcare professionals in the country.

At present, six government medical colleges in Tamil Nadu offer a total of 510 B.Sc. Nursing seats. Students admitted to these institutions pay an annual tuition fee of just 13,750, making government colleges a far more affordable option than private institutions, where annual tuition fees can be as high as 1.20 lakh. The proposed expansion comes in response to sustained demands from students and parents for additional government nursing seats. Officials said the initiative is expected to reduce the finan-



cial burden on families while increasing opportunities for aspiring nursing students. During the previous DMK administration, the state had initiated preliminary work to establish 10 new pharmacy and nursing colleges. However, those proposals did not progress to the implementation stage. The present TDP-led government has now decided to revive and expand the state's nursing and pharmacy education infrastructure. As part of the plan, B.Sc.

Nursing courses are proposed to be introduced in 14 government medical colleges across Tamil Nadu. The institutions identified for the expansion include medical colleges in Vellore, Tiruvannamalai, Dharmapuri, Tirunelveli, Tiruchirappalli and Namakkal, among others. Officials from the Directorate of Medical Education said the government has directed the department to increase the intake in paramedical education alongside undergraduate medical and dental programmes. The expansion is intended to strengthen the state's healthcare workforce by producing a larger pool of qualified nurses



Punjab BJP slams AAP govt, cites irregularities in Verka supply chain

Chandigarh, July 22 : Launching a scathing attack on the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP)-led Punjab government, State Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) Working President Ashwani Sharma, on Wednesday, alleged that Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann has maintained a deafening silence over a series of serious scams and irregularities linked to Verka and the nutrition supply chain, raising grave concerns about public health and systemic corruption. Sharma said that the recent rejection of nearly 125 metric tons of Verka milk powder by the Indian Army over quality concerns has once again exposed the rot within the system. "This is not an isolated incident but part of a larger pattern," he added, pointing to earlier allegations of chemical adulteration in milk supplied to Verka plants, multiple financial irregularities in different units, and now the shocking quality failure flagged by the Indian Army. He also highlighted the controversial Panjiri (Integrated Child Development Services Nutrition Scheme).

Central govt approves Rs 537.70 crore in assistance under Jal Jeevan Mission 2.0

The Ministry of Jal Shakti has approved central assistance of Rs 537.70 crore for Rajasthan under Jal Jeevan Mission 2.0 for the financial year 2026-27. The approved amount will be released as reimbursement of the Central Government's share of the additional expenditure incurred by the State Government from its own resources during the interim period between the completion of the first phase of the Jal Jeevan Mission and the commencement of Jal Jeevan Mission 2.0. The assistance will accelerate the implementation of rural drinking water projects across the state and provide crucial support in achieving the 'Har Ghar Jal' objective within the stipulated timeframe.

Mission Director, Jal Jeevan Mission, Rajan Vishal said the Central Government's approval marks a significant milestone in ensuring safe, clean and quality drinking water for lakhs of rural households across Rajasthan.

He added that the financial support will expedite the execution of water supply schemes and further strengthen rural drinking water infrastructure.

As per the Government of India's approval, the total assistance of Rs 537.70 crore comprises Rs 307.45 crore for General areas, Rs 177.73 crore under the Scheduled Caste component and Rs 52.52 crore under the Scheduled Tribe component.

The entire amount will be provided as reimbursement for expenditure incurred by the State Government on rural drinking water schemes. Rajan Vishal said Rajasthan has recorded significant progress in the effective implementation of the Jal Jeevan Mission. Of the 3,241 physically completed schemes in the state, 2,520 will soon be dedicated to the public through the final 'Jal Arpan' process in a phased manner.

He further informed that vouchers worth approximately Rs 713 crore, which were earlier not reflected on the relevant portals, have now been identified and submitted to the National Jal Jeevan Mission for entry. In addition, Central approval of Rs 537 crore has been received under the One-Time Settlement (OTS) for 3,346 schemes, while 3,864 schemes have been successfully onboarded onto the relevant module.

So far, more than 2,212 villages have been certified as 'Har Ghar Jal' villages across the state. Notably, around 705 new certifications have been secured during the past two months, reflecting the mission's accelerated progress.

Further, 'Sujalam Bharat' IDs have been generated for 93 per cent of the schemes, while requests for the remaining schemes have been forwarded to the National Jal Jeevan Mission. Excluding urban areas, 100 per cent water service assessment has been completed across all Gram Panchayats and villages. District Improvement Plans have also been prepared for 35 of Rajasthan's 40 districts, with the remaining plans scheduled for completion by July 31, 2026. Rajan Vishal said all assets approved under Jal Jeevan Mission 2.0 will be geo-tagged on the 'Sujalam Bharat' platform. The progress of schemes will also be updated regularly through the project monitoring module of the 'Sujalam' application, ensuring greater transparency, quality control and effective monitoring. The Government of India has extended the duration of the Jal Jeevan Mission until December 2028. Implemented through a 50:50 partnership between the Central and State Governments, the mission continues to play a pivotal role in providing safe and clean drinking water through functional household tap connections to every rural household. The Central assistance of Rs 537.70 crore is expected to provide fresh momentum to the implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission 2.0 in Rajasthan. It will strengthen rural drinking water infrastructure, facilitate the timely completion of ongoing and pending water supply projects, and reinforce the State Government's commitment to ensuring safe and clean drinking water for lakhs of rural families.

Suspected honour killing claims lives of police officer, 22-year-old woman in Pakistan

Islamabad, July 22 : A police personnel and a 22-year-old woman were allegedly shot dead in yet another case of honour killing in the Jalkot area of Upper Kohistan in Pakistan's Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province, local media reported on Wednesday. Speaking to journalists, Upper Kohistan DPO Tahir Iqbal Khan said, "The accused family first killed the woman and then the policeman after declaring them 'Chor' in accordance with a local custom after discovering that they were in a relationship", Pakistan's daily Dawn reported. The deceased policeman was posted at Dasu police station.

Historic cargo service between Kolkata and Nepal's Biratnagar begins

Kathmandu, July 22 : A first-ever rail cargo service between Kolkata and Biratnagar, an eastern city in Nepal, officially began on Wednesday, marking a major milestone in facilitating imports from third countries under the Nepal-India Transit Treaty. The inaugural freight train departed from Kolkata Port on Friday carrying 40 high-capacity containers bound for the Biratnagar Customs Yard, the Consulate General of Nepal in Kolkata said in a press statement. The inaugural service was jointly flagged off by Nepal's Consul General in Kolkata, Jhakka Prasad Acharya, along with officials from Kolkata Customs, Kolkata Port and the Container Corporation of India Limited (CONCOR). Until now, Birgunj, a city adjoining the Indian town of Raxaul, had been the country's only rail-linked customs point for containerized imports from seaports. The launch of the Biratnagar ser-

vice is expected to enable regular commercial transportation of both containerized and bulk cargo through eastern Nepal. "The first shipment comprises 40 forty-foot containers operated by Maersk Line, carrying Canola grain - farmer dressed, a raw material imported from a third country for Nepal's Swastik Oil Industries," the Consulate General said. The inaugural shipment was transported on a CONCOR freight train, and all containers have been fitted with the Electronic Cargo Tracking System (ECTS). With the full operation of the rail service, which passes through the Jogbani Integrated Customs Yard on the Nepal-India border before reaching Biratnagar, up to 45 forty-foot cargo containers can now be transported directly to Biratnagar in a single train, according to the Consulate General. "The inaugural movement comprises 40x40' containers carrying farmer-dressed bulk canola grain from Fremantle, Australia, mov-



ing under the aegis of Maersk Line. This seamless logistics solution, enabled through the collaborative efforts of Indian Railways, Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Customs, Maersk Line, Inland World Logistics and Transecure (ECTS), marks a significant step towards faster, more efficient and cost-effective trade. This service opens a new chapter in India-Nepal connectivity, strengthening regional trade and supply chain resilience," CONCOR's Area-IV (East) posted on X. The Consulate General said rail transport offers a safer, more reliable and lower-cost alternative to road transport, with cargo expected to reach Biratnagar in around 24 hours.

Bangladesh Gen Z protest erupts over exam crisis, 'farm chicken' remark by Education Minister

Dhaka, July 22 : Bangladesh has been gripped by a fresh wave of student protests, with Gen Z returning to the streets in Dhaka and other cities to press for education reforms less than five months after the Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) government came to power, a report has stated. The tensions emerged amid worsening weather conditions during the Higher Sec-

ondary Certificate (HSC) and equivalent examinations. The exams, which commenced on July 2 and involved nearly 1.3 million candidates, were disrupted by torrential rain during the second week of July. The heavy downpours caused widespread flooding in the Chittagong region and severe waterlogging in major cities, including Dhaka and Chittagong. As floods wreaked havoc in sev-



eral parts of Bangladesh, the Ministry of Education suspended examinations in five districts under the Chittagong Education Board. The move to keep exams on

schedule in other education boards, however, sparked outrage among students, according to a report in an online magazine, The Diplomat.



China row won't derail Xi trip: Navarro

Washington, July 22 : Senior White House adviser Peter Navarro on Wednesday indicated that allegations of Chinese interference in the 2020 US presidential election would not automatically alter the Trump administration's broader engagement with Beijing, saying election security and US-China policy should be treated as "separate

lanes" even as he defended President Donald Trump's push for tighter election safeguards. In an interaction with reporters at the White House a day after Trump unveiled declassified material that he said exposed vulnerabilities in the 2020 election, Navarro asked whether the allegations against Beijing could prompt changes to US trade policy, and replied: "I think they're

separate lanes." "China has already, predictably, denied everything, which you would expect," he said. "The story, this isn't a story about China. It's about the American refusal at the political level to safeguard our election system, and that happened because there are nefarious actors domestically who wanted that 2020 election to go in a different way than the voters did." Navarro nevertheless argued that material released by the Trump administration should raise fresh concerns about China's activities before the 2020 election. He alleged that China had accessed voter-related data and metadata in the run-up to the election, saying such actions, if undertaken, demonstrated "mal intent in terms of what you might do with that election." "That should raise really deep concerns among the American people," he said. Navarro also claimed newly declassified documents showed divisions within the US intelligence community over whether China was attempting to influence the election. According

to Navarro, those differences were not fully conveyed to the President through intelligence briefings. "We have revelations based on documents that have been released, that show that there was division among the intelligence community about whether or not the Chinese were influencing the election or were trying to steal the election or not," he said. When a reporter asked why China should not face consequences if it attempted to interfere in a US election, Navarro declined to discuss possible punitive measures. "That's a serious matter. It's not what I'm going to be talking about today," he said. Instead, he argued that the immediate priority should be strengthening domestic election safeguards. "I think the focus needs to be on the fact that there's holes in our election system that can and will be exploited by bad actors, both foreign and domestic."



Khasi Students' Union seals mosque in Shillong over alleged lack of permissions

Shillong, July 22 : The Khasi Students' Union (KSU) has sealed a mosque at 4th Furlong in Meghalaya's state capital of Shillong, alleging that the structure had been constructed without the mandatory approvals and supporting land documents, an official of student's body said. The action was carried out on Wednesday by members of the KSU's Shillong Mihngi Circle under the leadership of the organisation's Central Executive Commit-

tee (CEC) organising secretary Cleenstar Shabong. The drive coincided with the observance of the 191st death anniversary of Khasi freedom fighter, U Tirot Sing Syiem. According to a statement issued by the student body, the land on which the mosque stands is allegedly owned by Nurul Choudhary.

US lawmakers push Senate to clear crypto bill

Washington, July 22 : US lawmakers have urged the Senate to pass a sweeping digital assets bill, arguing that clear federal rules are needed to protect investors, bring cryptocurrency businesses back from overseas and preserve American leadership in financial technology. The House Financial Services Subcommittee on Digital Assets, Financial Technology and Artificial Intelligence made the case for the CLARITY Act during a hearing at New York’s

historic Federal Hall. The legislation would divide oversight responsibilities between the Securities and Exchange Commission and the Commodity Futures Trading Commission. “Our goal is clear: replace regulation by enforcement with clear rules of the road for digital assets,” subcommittee chairman Bryan Steil said. The House passed the legislation one year ago by a 294-134 vote. The Senate is now considering its own approach to regulating the digital asset market. French Hill, chairman of the full



House Financial Services Committee, said predictable rules were necessary to make the United States the centre of the global digital ecosystem. “This is President

Trump’s goal,” Hill said. “We stand ready to help our Senate colleagues complete the work and get it to the president’s desk.”

'If US attacks another NATO country, everything stops,' says Danish PM

Oslo, July 22 : Danish Prime Minister Mette Frederiksen said If the US attacks another NATO country, everything stops.

In an interview with Danish broadcaster DR on Wednesday, the Danish prime minister made the remarks in response to a question as to what it would mean if the United States were to use force against another NATO member. Frederiksen also slashed US President Donald Trump's renewed comments that the United States 'needs'



Greenland, denouncing his remarks as 'unacceptable pressure' on the self-governing territory. "Unfortunately, I think the American president should be taken seriously when he says he wants Greenland."

US threatens election funds over security

Washington, July 22 : The Trump administration said on Wednesday that US states could lose federal election funding unless they adopt new security measures, as it raised concerns about non-citizens on voter rolls and vulnerabilities in voting machines ahead of the midterm elections.

Homeland Security Secretary Markwayne Mullin said states seeking grants or reimbursement for conducting federal elections would be required to strengthen voting systems and review their registration lists. “We are not going to spend taxpayer dollars reimbursing a state that is refusing to secure their elections,” Mullin told a news conference.

South Korea's Foreign Ministry calls on Israel to investigate assault claims by activists

Seoul, July 22 : The foreign ministry os South Korea on Wednesday said it has pressed Israel to conduct a thorough investigation into claims by two South Korean activists that they were assaulted by Israeli forces after being detained aboard aid vessels bound for the Gaza Strip. The ministry said it called in the deputy Israeli ambassador to South Korea to its office on Saturday and conveyed its concerns over those allegations, Yonhap news agency reported. The two activists, Kim Ah-hyun and Kim Dong-hyeon, returned home Friday following their release. Upon arrival, they both said they had been assaulted by Israeli forces, with Kim Ah-hyun claiming that she had lost some hearing in her left ear because she had been struck on that side of the face several times. The ministry said it demanded a thorough investigation into the matter and stressed that appropriate measures



must be taken if inhumane acts by Israeli forces are found to be true. "The government expressed strong concerns over Israel's detention of two South Korean nationals," a ministry official said. "We take seriously the testimonies by our nationals that there had been

physical assaults by Israeli forces during their seizure of the vessels and detention of our people. We will respond to this situation with principle and responsibility and continue our diplomatic communication with relevant countries."

Abusive, vulgar words alone do not amount to obscenity under IPC: SC

New Delhi, July 22 : The Supreme Court on Wednesday held that the use of abusive and profane language during a heated altercation, however offensive or uncivil, would not by itself amount to the offence of obscenity punishable under Section 294(b) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), unless the words are lascivious, appeal to prurient interests and have the tendency to deprave and corrupt the minds of those exposed to them. A Bench of Justices Sanjay Karol and Vipul M. Pancholi made the observation while partly allowing an appeal filed by a 70-year-old

man convicted in a 2017 assault case arising out of a land dispute in Tamil Nadu. In its judgment, the apex court drew a clear distinction between "obscenity" and "vulgarity", saying that swear words and abusive expressions, though distasteful, cannot automatically attract criminal liability under Section 294(b) IPC. "Legally, obscenity is not synonymous with 'vulgarity', 'abuse' or 'profanity'. Use of mere swear words, profanities and vulgar expletives, however distasteful or uncivil they may be, cannot be equated with obscenity," the Justice Karol-led Bench observed. Explaining the legal

test, the top court said that an utterance would qualify as obscene only if it was lascivious, appealed to prurient interests, had the tendency to deprave and corrupt impressionable minds, and caused annoyance to others. "Words which are merely vulgar or abusive may evoke a feeling of disgust, revulsion or shock, but that by itself does not make them obscene in law," it added. In its judgment, the Supreme Court recorded that the appellant had allegedly used abusive expressions, including profanities, during the altercation. However, even if the allegations were accepted in their entirety, the words could only be described as abusive or vulgar and did not satisfy the ingredients of Section 294(b) IPC. "Such words, howsoever abusive, unpalatable or uncivil, do not satisfy the requirement of Section 294(b) IPC... Further, it is nobody's case that the use of such words caused annoyance to others in a public place, which is a mandatory ingredient of the Section," the judgment said while setting aside the conviction under Section 294(b). The apex court also quashed the appellant's conviction under Section 506(ii) IPC relating to criminal intimidation, holding that mere

threatening words uttered during an altercation would not constitute the offence unless it was proved that they were intended to cause alarm or compel the complainant to act or refrain from acting. "Mere use of threatening words during the course of an altercation, without the proof that it was intended to cause alarm to the complainant or to compel him to do or



omit to do any act, would not be sufficient," the Justice Karol-led Bench said. However, the Supreme Court upheld the conviction under Section 326 IPC for voluntarily causing grievous hurt by a dangerous weapon after finding that the complainant had suffered a fractured nasal bone in the assault with a billhook. The Justice Karol-led Bench held that the medical evidence fully corroborated the prosecution case and that the injury squarely fell within the definition of "grievous hurt" under Section 320 IPC. Taking into account that the incident stemmed from a land dispute, as well as the appellant's age and health condition, the apex court modified the sentence from one year's imprisonment to imprisonment till the rising of the court.

CM Chandrababu Naidu meets

Union Jal Shakti Minister CR Patil for Godavari - Kaveri River Linking Project

New Delhi, July 22 : AP Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu is busy in his Delhi visit. After meeting Prime Minister Narendra Modi, he held a series of meetings with several Union ministers. As part of this, the Chief Minister met Union Water Resources Minister CR Patil. It seems that key discussions were held on the interlinking of Godavari-Cauvery rivers. The CM requested the Union Minister to convene a meeting with the CMs of the partner states on the interlinking of Godavari-

Cauvery. It seems that the Union Water Resources Department has suggested that the interlinking of Cauvery from Banakacherla is better than the interlinking of Cauvery from Srisaillam. Keeping the interests of the country in mind, the Water Resources Department has requested Chandrababu to convene a special meeting with all the states and partner parties. The CM suggested to the Union Water Resources Minister that it would be better if the water is put to use than if it goes into the sea. He said that he has no ob-



jection to the central proposal if all the states are convinced. Chandrababu requested that a

special meeting be convened for this. It seems that the Union Water Resources Department has agreed to this.

High Court extends validity of journalist accreditation cards until Aug 3



Hyderabad, July 22 : The Telangana High Court on Wednesday extended the validity of existing journalist accreditation cards until August 3, while hearing a petition filed

by the Telangana Urdu Working Journalists' Federation (TUWJF). The petition was argued by Advocate Barkath Ali Khan, counsel for the petitioner. The court directed that the existing accreditation cards will remain valid until the next date of hearing, ensuring that accredited journalists continue to receive official recognition during the interim period. During the hearing, the High Court directed the petitioner to submit before the court a copy of the list of journalists whose accreditation extensions have been sought. The court noted that the same list had already been submitted to the Information and Public Relations (I&PR).

Three interstate Ganja peddlers arrested; 22.22 kg Ganja seized

Hyderabad, July 22 : The Commissioner's Task Force (Charminar Zone) and Balapur Police arrested three interstate ganja peddlers and seized 22.22 kg of dry ganja worth approximately Rs.12 lakh near Sadat Nagar Bus Stop in Shaheen Nagar. The arrested accused have been identified as Mirza Jaffer Baig alias Saddam, Awad Bin Ali Yafai, and Sardar Manpreet Singh Dhillion. Police also seized four mobile phones, two trolley bags and a backpack. According to police, the accused allegedly procured the contraband from Berhampur in Odisha at Rs.5,000 per kg and transported it to Hyderabad for sale. Hyundai Motor America recalls over 4 lakh vehicles over braking defect

New Delhi, July 22 : Hyundai Motor America -- the US unit of South Korean automaker firm -- has recalled more than 421,000 vehicles over a software defect that could trigger sudden and unexpected braking, increasing the risk of rear-end collisions, according to multiple reports.

Reports -- citing the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) -- said the recall affects certain 2025 and 2026 model-year variants of the Hyundai Tucson, Hyundai Tucson Hybrid, Hyundai Tucson Plug-In Hybrid and Hyundai Santa Cruz vehicles. According to the NHTSA safety

recall report, a software error in the front-facing camera module may cause the Forward Collision-Avoidance Assist (FCA) system to incorrectly detect obstacles on the road. The malfunction can result in the system activating emergency braking unexpectedly, even when no actual hazard is present.

Federal safety regulators said the issue stems from a defect in the vehicle's sensor framework, which may misinterpret environmental data and prematurely apply the brakes while the vehicle is in motion. The automaker reportedly received 376 consumer complaints related to sudden braking incidents between October 2024 and April 2026. The defect has been linked to four crashes and four injuries, though no severe injuries have been reported so far.



India's pharma sector bullish on pushing up exports

New Delhi, July 22 : India's pharmaceutical exports reached \$30.47 billion in FY 2025-26, registering a 9.4 per cent year-on-year growth, and are on track to surpass last year's performance in the current financial year, the Pharmaceuticals Export Promotion Council of India (PHARMEXCIL) informed Commerce Secretary Rajesh Agrawal on Wednesday. PHARMEXCIL also highlighted India's position as the third-largest pharmaceutical producer globally by volume and a trusted supplier of affordable, quality-assured medicines to over 150 countries,

which reflects the potential for long-term export-led growth. Tata Technologies' Q1 net profit falls 11.5 pc sequentially

Mumbai, July 22 : Tata Technologies Limited on Wednesday reported an 11.5 per cent sequential decline in consolidated net profit for the first quarter of FY27. The Tata Motors subsidiary posted a consolidated net profit of Rs 181 crore for the April-June quarter, compared with Rs 204 crore in the January-March quarter, according to its stock exchange filing. Revenue from operations increased 5.9 per cent quarter-on-quarter to Rs 1,665 crore from Rs 1,572

crore in the preceding quarter. The company's operating performance also improved during the quarter. Earnings before interest and taxes (EBIT) rose 7.5 per cent sequentially to Rs 221 crore from Rs 205 crore, while the EBIT margin expanded to 13.25 per cent from 13.06 per cent. The services business remained the key growth driver, with revenue rising 6.3 per cent sequentially and 34.6 per cent year-on-year to Rs 1,296.9 crore, as per its exchange filing. In US dollar terms, services revenue stood at \$136.6 million, registering a 4.3 per cent quarter-on-quarter increase in constant currency. At the end of the June quarter, Tata Technologies had a workforce of 12,579 employees, while its trailing 12-month attrition rate stood at 16 per cent.



Sensex, Nifty trade muted in early deals amid mixed global cues

Mumbai, July 22 : Domestic equity markets traded on a muted note in early deals on Wednesday amid mixed global cues and a decline in crude oil prices. Sensex was trading at 76,050, up 40 points or 0.05 per cent in the morning session, while Nifty rose 20 points or 0.08 per cent to 23,932. Earlier, the benchmark indices opened at 75,939.86 and 23,880.35, respectively. Among sectoral indices, Nifty Metal emerged as the top gainer, climbing 1.59 per cent, followed by Nifty Cement, which advanced 0.83 per cent.

Smartphone shipments in India drop 10 pc in June quarter over memory prices

New Delhi, July 22 : India's smartphone shipments fell 10 per cent (year-on-year) in the April-June quarter, the biggest for a June quarter in six years, a report showed on Wednesday. The decline was mainly driven by record-high memory prices, which increased smartphone prices across almost all segments, weakening consumer demand and extending replacement cycles, despite promotions and financing initiatives, according to Counterpoint Research. India's smartphone market remained under pressure during the quarter, as both demand and supply were adversely affected. "On the supply side, persistent increases in memory and other component costs prompted almost every major OEM to implement multiple rounds of price hikes, resulting in an average smartphone price hike of around 15 per cent by the end of the second quarter."



ONGC ties up with BP unit to boost output from Western Offshore fields

New Delhi, July 22 : State-run oil explorer Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) on Wednesday said it has selected BP Exploration Services India Limited -- a UK-based subsidiary of BP Plc -- as Technical Services Provider (TSP) for its Western Offshore oil and gas fields (excluding the Mumbai High field), in a move aimed at boosting output from mature assets. The decision follows an international competitive bidding process under which global oil companies were invited to submit proposals for improving recovery from ageing offshore fields in the Mumbai Offshore Basin. ONGC said the selected TSP will assess field performance and recommend interventions across reservoirs, wells and facilities to enhance production, leveraging global best practices and advanced technologies.



Reliance Industries' Q1 revenue jumps 25 pc to Rs 3.11 lakh crore; profit at Rs 20,946 crore

Mumbai, July 22 : Billionaire Mukesh Ambani-led Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) on Wednesday reported a robust 25 per cent year-on-year increase in consolidated revenue to Rs 3.11 lakh crore for the first quarter of FY27, driven by strong double-digit growth across its Oil-to-Chemicals (O2C), retail and digital services businesses. The company posted a consolidated net profit of Rs 20,946 crore, down 22 per cent from a year ago due to the absence of the one-time exceptional gain from the sale of its Asian Paints stake in the corresponding quarter of FY26. The conglomerate's net profit had jumped to Rs 26,994 crore in the first quarter of 2025-26 (Q1 FY26) due to the sale of Asian Paints stake. EBITDA during the quarter increased by 10 per cent year-on-year to Rs 54,067 crore, according to a company statement. The performance beat street expectations, driven by double-digit growth across key businesses, including the Oil-to-Chemicals (O2C) segment, Reliance Retail, and digital services platform Jio. RIL chairman

Mukesh Ambani said: "Reliance has made a steady start to FY27, with all businesses delivering strong operating performance. Our diverse business portfolio has once again demonstrated its resilience in a quarter which witnessed continuing geopolitical tensions and volatile commodity markets." The Digital Services business continued its growth momentum during the quarter. Jio's performance across mobility, home broadband and enterprise services remained strong, driving healthy earnings growth of 15 per cent Y-o-Y. During the quarter, Jio Platforms Limited filed its DRHP with SEBI, a significant step towards its public listing. Reliance Retail delivered resilient growth this quarter, with steady performance across all consumption formats and channels.

As per sources, the consumer watchdog, led by Nidhi Khare, has asked the Director General (DG) of the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) to probe the matter. The BIS chief has been asked to submit the report within 15 days. Last month,



Ola Electric claimed that 99.1 per cent of the 10,644 complaints on the National Consumer Helpline (NCH) were resolved. The company was handed over a show-cause notice by the CCPA over alleged violations of consumer rights. However, despite

age C-DOT's portfolio of cutting-edge, homegrown technological solutions to boost the operational efficiency, secure communications, surveillance, cybersecurity, and emergency response capabilities of Delhi Police." C-DOT will deploy solutions including a Facial Recognition System (FRS)/FraudPro for suspect or missing person identification and

crowd monitoring. It can identify repeat offenders through photograph-matching with available databases, strengthening investigation processes, crowd monitoring, and identity verification during law-and-order deployments, the statement said. SAMVAD, a unified communication platform for one-to-one and group chats, audio/video calls, and



official data sharing, enabling seamless and secure coordination across units, districts, and

specialised branches during both routine operations and emergencies, will also be deployed.

the NEET-UG issue, saying the agitation would continue unabated. Speaking to reporters, Pawar said, "We had anticipated that they would arrest him within five or six days, and that is exactly what has happened.

Safeguard economic, energy security: Punjab CM to Centre

Chandigarh, July 22 : As global tensions escalate in Gulf countries and disruptions in key maritime routes trigger uncertainty across markets, Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann on Wednesday called on the Centre to act decisively, urging Prime Minister Narendra Modi to take responsibility and leverage India's global relationships to safeguard the country's economic and energy security. He cautioned that while PM Modi speaks of becoming a 'vishwa guru', the current tra-

jectory risks reducing it to a 'vishwa chela' if timely and effective intervention is not made. Citing the virtual meeting convened by the Prime Minister with Chief Ministers, CM Mann stated, "A war-like situation in Gulf countries has created panic across the world. The disruption of key sea routes is emerging as a major obstacle in global trade and supply chains." He highlighted that each state presented its concerns in detail, noting that while some states depend on mining or coastal trade, Punjab's economy is closely tied to agriculture, industry, and its border location.

Emphasising the urgency of the situation, he said, "This is the time for the Prime Minister to step forward and play a responsible role in stopping the war. The strong relationships that the Prime Minister shares with leaders across countries must now be used in the interest of 140 crore Indians." Flagging immediate concerns for Punjab, particularly with the ongoing wheat procurement season, the Chief Minister added, "As wheat arrivals begin in mandis, it must be ensured that there is



no shortage of petrol and diesel in Punjab. Any disruption in fuel supply will directly impact farmers, transportation and procurement operations." CM Mann further said, "This is the moment for India to translate its global standing into concrete action that protects its people." Calling for urgent and co-ordinated intervention, the Chief Minister stressed that the Centre must act swiftly to stabilise supply chains, ensure uninterrupted fuel availability, and protect the country from the cascading impact of global instability.

Global conflicts behind price rise, situation likely to improve: Assam BJP MLA

Guwahati, July 22 : Senior Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) MLA and former Assam Minister Prashanta Phukan on Wednesday attributed the ongoing rise in prices to global conflicts and said the situation is expected to gradually improve in the coming months.

Talking to reporters here, Phukan said inflation and price rises are not issues limited to Assam or India alone, but are part of a broader global economic situation driven by international conflicts and instability. "The price rise that we are witnessing today is linked to a global situation. Wars and conflicts are taking place across the world, and these developments are having an impact on the economy and prices everywhere," the BJP leader said. According to Phukan, the current international environment has disrupted economic stability and created pressure on the supply chain, which in turn has affected the prices of essential commodities and other goods. He, however, expressed optimism that the situation would stabilise with time and that inflationary pressure would gradually ease. "I believe that after some time, the situation will improve.



Arunachal cabinet clears Rs 7,834 crore package, major reforms

Itanagar, July 22 : The Arunachal Pradesh Cabinet, chaired by Chief Minister Pema Khandu, on Wednesday approved a Rs 7,834-crore development package, along with governance, education, infrastructure, and employment reforms aimed at improving the ease of living, ease of doing business, and public service delivery in the state. A senior official of the Chief Minister's Office (CMO) said investments were cleared for four flagship Chief Minister's Comprehensive Schemes for 2026-29. An outlay of Rs 2,334 crore was approved for Phase-II of the Chief Minister's Comprehensive State Road Development Plan (CMCSRDP) to improve connectivity in district headquarters, sub-divisional headquarters and the Capital Complex. Officials were directed to complete pending projects under Phase-I by March 2027. The Cabinet sanctioned Rs 2,000 crore for the Chief Minister's Comprehensive State Rural Road Development Programme (CMCSRRDP) to provide all-weather connectivity to habitations not covered under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY). Another Rs 2,000 crore was approved under the Chief Minister's Comprehensive State Power Development Programme

(CMCSPDP) to modernise power infrastructure and reduce Aggregate Technical and Commercial (AT&C) losses to 18 per cent by March 2029. Rs 1,500 crore was cleared for Phase-II of Mission Shikshita Arunachal (2026-29) to bridge school infrastructure gaps, strengthen teacher training, enhance digital monitoring and improve learning outcomes. The cumulative Rs 7,834 crore investment aims to converge Central and State schemes to address critical infrastructure and education gaps, representing one of the biggest packages by the Pema Khandu government in recent years. The Cabinet rolled out the AI-powered e-HRMS 2.0 (Manav Sampada) platform to digitise the entire lifecycle of government employees, from recruitment to retirement, and directed all departments to adopt it expeditiously. Among other decisions, the Cabinet approved the Chief Minister's Frontier Sainik School Scholarship Scheme to support students in notified Sainik Schools and the Rashtriya Indian Military College, Dehradun. It also cleared an Indian Army-led mentorship programme to help Arunachal youths prepare for admission to military institutions and pursue careers in the armed forces.

Jodhpur Police prepare to take beautician's murderer to crime spot

Jaipur, July 22 : Jodhpur beautician Anita Chaudhary's murderer, arrested in Mumbai, would be taken to the spot where he chopped the 50-year-old woman's body and buried it in a pit, a police official said on Wednesday. Gulamuddin Farooqui (42) was arrested in Mumbai on Wednesday and Rajasthan Police took his transit remand from a court before bringing him to Jodhpur, said the official. On his arrival on Friday from Mumbai, the police plan to take him to the crime scene and question about the victim's gold ornaments that he allegedly stole after the murder. Anita, who ran a beauty parlour in the Sardarpura area of Jodhpur, was brutally murdered in the afternoon on October 26. On Thursday evening, Jodhpur Police raided a house in south Mumbai and arrested



Gulamuddin with the help of Mumbai Police. Gulamuddin was absconding since Anita's murder. A team led by Additional DCP Nishant Bhardwaj was hunting for him for four days in Mumbai, said an official. Police claimed that Gulamuddin, whose shop faced the victim's parlour, killed Anita to steal her ornaments while she was returning home.



Ultras change strategies, we must thwart conspiracy: NC's Bashir on Kishtwar attack

Jammu, July 22 : A day after two Village Defence Committee (VDC) members were kidnapped and killed by terrorists in Jammu and Kashmir (J&K)'s Kishtwar district, National Conference (NC) leader Sheikh Bashir on Wednesday said a major conspiracy was underway. An offshoot of the Jaish-e-Mohammad terrorist organisation called the 'Kashmir Tigers' claimed responsibility for the attack in Kishtwar district.



India ahead of China in QS Asia University rankings for second time in a row

New Delhi, July 22 : India has for the second consecutive year outperformed China in the QS Asia University Rankings 2026, signalling a significant improvement in the country's higher education. With 193 Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) ranked in the list from India, the country showed the highest growth in university representation. The list also includes 21 new entrants. India was followed by China

with 135 universities, and Japan with 115 universities, according to the latest annual list of Asia's best universities released by global higher education analyst Quacquarelli Symonds. India surpassed China in the 2024 QS ranking with 148 ranked universities. Only 133 educational institutes from China made to the list last year. The 2026 edition features 984 universities across 25 higher education systems in Asia.

Kolkata, July 22 : The new Chief Minister Suwendu Adhikari-led Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP)-ruled West Bengal government on Wednesday took an in-principle decision to implement the state's crucial flood control-cum-drainage project, popularly known as the "Ghatal Master Plan", jointly

with the Union government, with the expenditure to be shared equally between the Centre and the state. The project had long remained stalled because of the reluctance of the previous Trinamool Congress-ruled and Mamata Banerjee-led state government.

Delhi CM Rekha Gupta approves Rs 33.31 crore for farmers hit by last year's rain

New Delhi, July 22 : In a welfare decision for farmers, the Delhi government led by Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Wednesday approved an ex-gratia assistance of more than Rs 33.31 crore for agriculturists whose crops were destroyed due to heavy rain and waterlogging during August and September 2025. She said the affected farmers will receive relief at the rate of Rs 75,000 per hectare. Under this decision, the assistance will directly benefit farmers

across more than 4,442.41 hectares of affected agricultural land spread across different districts and sub-divisions of Delhi. The amount will be transferred directly to the bank accounts of eligible farmers through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) from next month, the Chief Minister added. The Chief Minister directed the Revenue Department and the concerned District Magistrates to begin the distribution process without any delay so that the relief amount reaches the bank accounts of eligible farmers at the earliest.



She said the Delhi government stands firmly with its farmers in both good times and bad. "The assistance is an effort to help farmers recover from the heavy losses caused by nature's fury," he added. She said that the affected areas have been assessed as having suffered 100 per cent crop loss, and the assistance will be transferred directly to eligible farmers with complete transparency. The

Chief Minister added that, as per the Delhi government's decision, a total of 4,442.41 hectares of affected agricultural land across various districts and sub-divisions in Delhi has been brought under the relief scheme. The approved assistance includes Rs 2.74 crore for 364.74 hectares in Alipur (Narela), Rs 13 lakh for 17.33 hectares in Burari, Rs 38.63 lakh for 51.50 hectares in Punjabi Bagh (Mundka), and Rs 19.92 lakh for 26.55 hectares in Vikaspuri. Similarly, under the Kanjhawala area, relief of Rs 8.70 crore and Rs 4.49 crore has been approved.

Lok Nayak, Malviya hospitals of Delhi govt win quality certification

New Delhi, July 22 : Delhi's healthcare system has achieved a significant milestone with Lok Nayak Hospital and Pt. Madan Mohan Malviya Hospital is being conferred the 'Quality Certified' recognition under the National Quality Assurance Standards (NQAS) framework, said Health Minister Pankaj Kumar Singh on Wednesday. Lok Nayak Hospital secured an impressive 95.89 per cent while Pt. Madan Mohan Malviya Hospital achieved an outstanding 96.72 per cent in the national quality assessment process, the Minister said. The certification has been awarded based on excellence demonstrated across multiple critical healthcare domains, including OPD services, ICU facilities, Blood Bank, Labour Room, Radiology, Laboratories, Emergency Care, Maternal Health Services, and several other clinical and support departments. "Unlike the previous government, we believe in work, not empty promises. For years, Delhi's healthcare system suffered due to a lack of vision, accountability, and meaningful reforms," said Pankaj Kumar Singh. "Under the Kayakalp initiative, proper emphasis is laid on cleanliness and hygiene across all Delhi government hospitals. In the coming period, 14 MRI machines and more than 25 ultrasound machines will be made available in government hospitals," he said. He said advanced healthcare services are being ensured across Delhi Government hospitals, and it remains our commitment that every individual should have easy access to treatment. The achievement marks an important step towards strengthening Delhi's public healthcare ecosystem



and reflects the Delhi Government's sustained focus on delivering better, modern, and reliable healthcare services to citizens. The Minister said under the broader vision of the Delhi government led by Chief Minister Rekha Gupta, continuous efforts are being undertaken to enhance quality standards, infrastructure, and patient experience across healthcare institutions in the national capital. The Health Minister said that Delhi Government hospitals are continuously advancing towards global benchmarks in healthcare delivery, with enhanced cleanliness, stronger medical infrastructure, and expanded access to diagnostic services. The planned augmentation of MRI and ultrasound machines across government hospitals will further improve diagnostic capacity and reduce patient inconvenience, he said.

Singapore records more young cheating offenders

Singapore, July 22 : Up to 422 young people committed cheating offences in Singapore last year, increasing from 260 in 2019, according to the Supporting Youth Rehabilitation Trends Report issued by the Ministry of Social and Family Development on Wednesday. The offending rate for youths below 21 years in Singapore was 4.9 per 1,000 people in 2023, compared to the rate of 4.6 per 1,000 people in 2022. The top three crimes committed by youth offenders were shop theft, cheating and related offences, and sexual offenses. Completion rates across rehabilitation programmes remained at around 90 per cent in 2023. The overall two-year recidivism rate remained below 10 per cent among young offenders who completed rehabilitation from 2019 to 2021, according to the report.



Gujarat records over 6.54 lakh private sector jobs through recruitment fairs in five years

Gandhinagar, July 22 : More than 6.54 lakh young people have secured employment in Gujarat over the past five years through large-scale recruitment fairs organised across the state, according to an official statement from the state's Employment and Training Department. The figures cover the period from 2021-22 to 2025-26 and indicate that 7,403 recruitment fairs were held during this period, with participation from over 28,000 private-sector employers. The department said the initiative has been designed to ease hiring by directly connecting job-seeking candidates with companies through on-the-spot interview processes.

Rwanda adopts new disaster risk policy, urges united action

Kigali, July 22 : Rwandan Minister of Emergency Management Albert Murasira announced Wednesday the government's adoption of a new disaster risk reduction and management policy, urging all stakeholders to integrate the policy's actions into their plans with the collective goal of building a resilient nation.

He made these remarks at the national conference on disaster risk reduction and management in Kigali, Rwanda's capital, held to mark the International Day for Disaster Risk Reduction, under the theme "Understanding the Root Causes of Disaster Risks in Rwanda: From National Policies and Plans to Proactive Actions." Murasira called on participants to strengthen collaboration and part-

nerships to effectively implement the disaster risk reduction and management policy, Xinhua news agency reported. "Good disaster risk management is not the responsibility of one ministry, agency, or partner alone but requires a coalition," said Ozonnia Ojiele, UN resident coordinator for Rwanda. He said that disasters are now predictable in their unpredictability.



Defining reforms driving India towards Viksit Bharat: Indian envoy to Thailand

Bangkok, July 22 : India's Ambassador to Thailand Nagesh Singh on Wednesday highlighted India's economic and technological progress while addressing a session on "The Dynamics of Change: India's Economic Journey in the 21st Century" at the Asia Partnership Forum 2026 in Bangkok. He emphasised that through a series of defining reforms rooted in democratic principles, India is



advancing towards the goal of a Viksit Bharat by 2047. "Ambassador Nagesh Singh delivered a talk on 'The Dynamics of Change.

'Democracy alien to dump truck Islamabad': India lambasts Pakistan at UN

United Nations, July 22 : India has slammed Pakistan over its diatribes on Kashmir, saying the traditions of democracy are "alien" to it. Speaking at the General Assembly Committee on Social, Humanitarian and Cultural issues, Indian Member of Parliament PP Chaudhary lambasted Pakistan, saying that

nothing can be expected of a country whose Army chief called it a "dump truck". He said that the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir has made astounding progress "in multiple spheres" and this "attests to focused attention paid by India to improve the daily lives of citizens." "Democratic traditions and values



are alien to Pakistan, and it is not a surprise that they have chosen not to account for the will of the people by them as recently as October 2025," he said. "A country that regularly rigs its elections, jails its popular leaders.

Kenya airport deal proves China's disinformation drive to win African infra projects

New Delhi, July 22 : China continues to use media influence, psychological operations and debt diplomacy to secure over-priced deals in Kenya and other African countries, a new report alleged, citing an example of a recent contract to expand Kenya's international airport.

The contract could deepen Kenya's financial dependence and compromise sovereignty, the report from The Mount Kenya Times said.

Beijing secures strategic projects "by hook or by crook," the report said, adding that Kenya already owes billions to China for previous infrastructure projects, including railways and highways.

Prima facie, the contract for Kenya's international airport expansion was inflated nearly one and a half times higher than the previous proposal. However, the Kenyan government awarded the contract to a Chinese state-owned enterprise, under immense pressure. The tactic combines state-backed media, sponsored content and covert support from local journalists to shape public opinion in favour of the Chinese bid while discrediting alternatives.



Most UN Security Council members criticise Maduro's capture; US says it's 'law enforcement,' not war

United Nations, July 22 : Facing criticism at the Security Council from allies and adversaries for capture of Venezuelan leader Nicolas Maduro, the US has defended it as a "a law enforcement operation" and not a war.

At the Council's emergency meeting on Wednesday, France and Britain, US allies with permanent membership on the Council, lobbed mild criticism at Washington from an international law perspective. The other two permanent members, China and Russia, lashed out at the US, demanding Maduro's immediate release.

"There is no war against Venezuela or its people", US Permanent Representative Mike Walz declared, quoting Secretary of State Marco Rubio.

"We are not occupying a country".

Attempting to undercut arguments that the US was violating the UN Charter and international law by invading Venezuela, he asserted, "This was a law enforcement operation".

"The United States arrested a narcotrafficker who is now going to stand trial in the United States in accordance with the rule of law for the crimes he's committed against our people for 15 years", he added.

Taiwan accuses China of transnational repression after state media targets DPP lawmaker

Taipei, July 22 : Taiwanese government has accused China of transnational repression after Chinese state media and social media accounts shared personal information regarding Democratic Progressive Party (DPP) Legislator Puma Shen, which included satellite pictures of his house and workplace in Taipei, local media reported. Taiwan's Ministry of Foreign Affairs stated that China's state-controlled media were using "digital authoritarianism" and the "despicable" way of doxxing to threaten Taiwanese, trying to create fear and a chilling effect in democratic society of Taiwan, Taiwan's daily Taipei Times reported.

In a post shared on Facebook on January 2, Strait Plus, a media channel operated by a Chinese



state-controlled media organisation, wrote that a Chinese influencer had revealed the location of Shen's house and workplace. According to the post, the influencer said that she had paid for commercial satellite imagery of Taipei and marked Shen's house and workplace on it. She said that China's Chongqing Municipal Public Security Bureau in 2025 had declared Puma Shen as "wanted" amid a probe into alleged "secession-related" criminal activities in Taiwan.

Knife attack in Bihar's Nawada leaves two dead, two critically injured

Patna, July 22 : A violent clash over an old dispute turned deadly on Wednesday afternoon around 2.30 p.m. in Chhoti Pali village under the jurisdiction of Narhat Police Station in Bihar's Nawada district, where two youths were stabbed to death and two others sustained serious injuries in a knife attack.

According to the SHO of Narhat Police Station, the deceased were identified as Mohammad Kashif, the 22-year-old son of Mohammad Arif, and Mohammad Ahmed, the 22-year-old son of Mohammad Imtiaz.

Another family member, Mohammad Atif, suffered serious stab injuries during the attack.

From the opposing side, Najjan Parveen, daughter of Mohammad Fahim Parveen, was also injured.

"We reached the spot soon after the incident and shifted the injured to a nearby hospital. Due to the severity of their condition, they were later referred to Nawada Sadar Hospital and subsequently to Patna Medical College and Hospital (PMCH) for advanced treatment," the SHO said.



The incident created an atmosphere of fear and tension in the village.

A cousin of the deceased, Mohammad Danish, alleged that his family had been receiving threats from the accused side for a long time.

According to him, barely an hour before the killings, members of the rival faction had intercepted them on the road and openly threatened to kill them.

Danish claimed that shortly afterwards, a group of five to six armed men suddenly attacked his brothers with knives.

He alleged that Kashif and Ahmed died on the spot during the assault, while Atif was stabbed when he tried to save them.

He further claimed that the conflict stemmed from an incident around six months ago in which the accused had allegedly harassed his cousin publicly.

Absconding BDO accused in Bengal gold trader murder case arrested

Kolkata, July 22 : Prashant Barman, the long-absconding former Block Development Officer (BDO) of Raiganj Block in North Dinajpur district of West Bengal, who was accused in the case of the abduction and murder of gold merchant Swapan Kamilya at Salt Lake's Dattabad in Kolkata last year, has finally been arrested. Burman's arrest, which happened in New Town on the northern outskirts of Kolkata around midnight on Wednes-

day, was coincidental and dramatic. According to information passed down by the Bidhannagar City Police, under whose jurisdiction New Town comes, Burman, while driving his car in a totally intoxicated state at night, had hit a two-wheeler rider. The two-wheeler rider somehow stood up and blocked the path of Burman's vehicle and asked him to get out of the vehicle. Instead of being apologetic, Burman, in a totally intoxicated state, started abusing him. Soon, some local people as-



sembled at the place and Burman started abusing them as well. One of the local persons assembled there, recorded Burman's entire abusive behaviour and later circulated it on social media, the authenticity of which could not be ascertained by IANS. As the situation became more tense at the spot, the cops from the local Ecopark Police Station.

Delhi Police busts inter-state liquor smuggling syndicate, illicit liquor worth Rs 1.5 crore recovered

New Delhi, July 22 : The Delhi Police's South District personnel on Wednesday busted a well-organised inter-state liquor smuggling syndicate operating between Delhi, Gurugram, and Bengaluru, recovering illicit liquor worth approximately Rs 1.50 crore and arresting three bootleggers involved in the racket.

According to Delhi Police, the operation was carried out by the Mehrauli Police Station team following sustained surveillance, patrolling, and intelligence gathering in the area amid repeated incidents related to illicit liquor smuggling. Police said a dedicated team had been constituted to identify and apprehend bootleggers operating within the jurisdiction

of PS Mehrauli. On May 18, while conducting routine patrolling in the Mehrauli area, police intercepted a tempo being driven by accused Akhilesh Kumar Singh. During inspection, the vehicle was found loaded with 63 boxes of illicit liquor. The illicit liquor, along with the vehicle, was immediately seized, and legal proceedings were initi-



ated. During sustained interrogation, accused Akhilesh Kumar Singh disclosed that he used to transport illicit liquor to Okhla Railway Station at the instructions of co-accused Upender Singh and his son Ankit Singh in exchange for monetary benefits.

Acting on the information provided by the accused, police conducted a raid at the residence of Upender Singh and Ankit Singh in Rajpur Khurd village in Delhi. During the raid, 11 additional boxes of illicit liquor were recovered, and both accused were ap-

prehended on the spot. Further interrogation revealed that the accused procured illicit liquor from Mohit, a resident of Gurugram, and transported the consignments to railway parcel booking points through the intercepted tempo. The consignments were then allegedly dispatched to Bengaluru under the guise of commercial goods. At the instance of the accused persons, another six boxes of illicit liquor were recovered from a car, which was also seized in the case.

Three persons injured in Bihar road accident

Patna, July 22 : Three people sustained serious injuries following a collision with a high-speed vehicle in Bihar's East Champaran district on Wednesday. Enraged by the incident, locals gathered at the scene, apprehended the driver, and assaulted him. Following the escalation, Dumaria Ghat police officers arrived to rescue the driver but met with stiff resistance from the crowd.

Indian American Khanna to succeed Krishnamoorthi as top Democrat on China panel

Washington, July 22 : House Democratic Leader Hakeem Jeffries on Wednesday announced that Indian American Congressman Ro Khanna will take over as Ranking Member of the House Select Committee on the Strategic Competition Between the United States and the Chinese Communist Party, while commending outgoing panel leader Raja Krishnamoorthi for his leadership over the past three years. In a statement, Jeffries praised

Krishnamoorthi's tenure, saying he had led the committee "with grace and resolve" during a period of heightened scrutiny of U.S.-China relations. He said that throughout his time as Ranking Member, Krishnamoorthi "worked diligently and in a bipartisan way to strengthen our global competitiveness and to

advance American economic and national security interests."

"Our nation is safer and more secure because of Raja's commitment to public service," Jeffries said, thanking him "on behalf of House Democrats" for his leadership and continued dedication to the work of the committee.



Andy Burnham confirmed as Britain's Labour Party leader, set to become new PM

London, July 22 : Britain's Labour Party announced Wednesday that Andy Burnham has been confirmed as its leader. Burnham, former Mayor of Greater Manchester, is expected to be appointed prime minister on Wednesday after Keir Starmer formally steps down, in accordance with established procedure. Speaking at the Trades Union Congress headquarters in central London, British Home Secretary Shabana Mahmood, who also chairs Labour's National Executive Committee, said Burnham had received nominations from 379 Labour lawmakers. As the only candidate to reach the required threshold, he was declared leader without a ballot of party members. Burnham returned to parliament after winning the Makerfield by-election, whose result was declared on June 19. Starmer announced his resignation as Labour leader on June 22, saying he would remain Prime Minister until his suc-

cessor was chosen, Xinhua news agency reported. In his speech, Burnham recalled working with Keir Starmer about a decade ago to draft the original version of the Hillsborough law following the second Hillsborough inquest, drawing on Starmer's legal expertise. Burnham said Britain had taken a series of wrong turns since the 1980s, as political power became increasingly centralised while essential services such as housing, water, energy and transport were privatised. He argued that this had driven up costs, concentrated wealth and power in fewer hands and left

many former industrial towns without the authority to rebuild their economies. "I will be a leader for the north, the south, the east and the west," he said. After having led the Labour Party to a massive election win in July 2024, the first in 14 years, Starmer faced criticism for the policies adopted by his government. The number of MPs supporting Andy Burnham for the Labour leadership has increased after his triumphant victory in the Makerfield by-election.



Trump official Peter Navarro urges election overhaul

Washington, July 22 : Senior White House trade adviser Peter Navarro on Wednesday defended President Donald Trump's renewed focus on election integrity, arguing that newly declassified material had strengthened public concerns about vulnerabilities in the US electoral system and underscored the need for Congress to pass the proposed Save America Act. A day after Trump's nationally televised address, Navarro told reporters at the White House that the administration's objective was not to relitigate the 2020 presidential election but to strengthen safeguards for future polls.

"That's not what last night was about. What last night was about is protecting future elections," Navarro said. He argued that the newly released material had prompted Americans to reassess the integrity of the 2020 election, asking whether "the probability that that election was stolen" had risen "because of what came out." Navarro outlined what he described as four major issues emerging from the declassified documents. He first alleged that China had accessed US voter-related data before the 2020 election, saying such activity should raise "deep concerns among the American people." He argued that obtaining

voter information and metadata suggested "mal intent" even though Beijing had denied the allegations. He also criticised what he described as divisions within the US intelligence community over China's alleged election activities. Referring to documents released by the administration, Navarro said they showed disagreements that were not reflected in presidential intelligence briefings. "There was one very chilling comment," he said, referring to "an FBI agent, who bragged about running a shadow government... to keep key intelligence off the desk of the president." Navarro further claimed the documents showed that voting machines were "vulnerable to being used to sway elections" and that such activity "may well be undetectable when that kind of nefarious activity takes place." He also pointed to what he said were nearly 300,000 illegal voters identified by the Department of Homeland Security in a limited number of states. He argued that even relatively small numbers could influence closely contested elections. Using Georgia as an example, Navarro repeated his longstanding criticism of changes to absentee voting procedures during the 2020 election.



New positive for Hantavirus confirmed among quarantined Spaniards

Madrid, July 22 : The Spanish Ministry of Health confirmed a new positive case of hantavirus among the 14 Spaniards who were among the passengers of the cruise ship MV Hondius affected by an outbreak of the disease while crossing the Atlantic Ocean in April. The 14 Spanish nationals from the vessel were evacuated from the island of Tenerife in a tightly controlled operation on May 10 and have since remained in preventive quarantine at Madrid's Gomez Ulla Central Defence Hospital. The latest positive case was detected during routine PCR testing conducted under the isolation.

UN human rights office raises serious concerns about deadly unrest in PoK

Geneva, July 22 : The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) on Wednesday raised serious concern about infringements on the rights to freedom of expression, peaceful assembly and association in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK) amid escalating unrest in the occupied territory that has left dozens of people dead and injured. In a statement issued, Spokesperson for the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, Jeremy Laurence, said that "the criminalisation of a civil society organisation and imposition of strict limitations on gatherings raise serious concerns about infringements on the rights to freedom of expression, peaceful assembly and association. Detained JAAC leaders must have access to legal representation and their families. Their rights to due process and fair trial must be fully guaranteed." According to the statement, the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, Volker Turk, has called for calm and urged prompt, thorough and



impartial investigations into all deaths that have occurred due to the unrest, both amongst protesters and members of security forces. The spokesperson noted that dozens of civilians, including law enforcement personnel, have reportedly been killed since June as tensions mounted ahead of the

July 27 election in PoK. Expressing grave concerns over Pakistani authorities' response to the protest, the UN human rights office said, "The Joint Awami Action Committee (JAAC) - a movement behind the protests comprising traders, transporters, students, lawyers, activists and others - has been banned under anti-terrorism laws for allegedly threatening public order and security. Some of the group's leaders have subsequently been arrested." The statement noted that the restrictions on internet access in the region were disproportionately undermining the right.



Brazil urges respect for international law, negotiation amid US threats against Cuba

Sao Paulo, July 22 : Brazilian Foreign Affairs Minister Mauro Vieira expressed his country's rejection of US threats against Cuba, and called for resolving differences through diplomacy and respect for international law. Regarding possible US military intervention in Cuba, Vieira on Wednesday said he hopes it would not come to that, and the better option is "negotiation and dialogue."



South Korean President Lee reiterates plan to designate December 3 as day for people's sovereignty

Seoul, July 22 : South Korean President Lee Jae Myung on Wednesday reiterated his plan to designate December 3 as a day of people's sovereignty that would mark the anniversary of former President Yoon Suk Yeol's failed imposition of martial law. In a Facebook post marking the 78th Constitution Day, Lee pledged to designate December 3 as a legal public holiday so that the meaning and spirit of the day -- when ordinary citizens voluntarily sought to block the unexpected martial law -- could be fully passed down to future generations, Yonhap News Agency re-

ported. Lee made a similar proposal last year to mark the first anniversary of the political crisis triggered by Yoon's declaration of martial law. "On December 3, 2024, the martial law declared in the middle of the night reminded all of us that the threat to democracy is by no means a thing of the past, but a reality that could happen again at any time in today's Republic of Korea," Lee said in the post, referring to the country by its official name. He further said South Korea had demonstrated to the world through a "revolution of light" that the spirit of popular sovereignty enshrined in the Constitution is alive

and breathing in people's daily lives. Lee also highlighted the presidential "Committee of Light," which was launched earlier this week to honor people who contributed to protecting the Constitution and democracy. The committee, which consists of no more than 35 members, including experts in constitutional law and democracy, will establish basic directions for promoting Korean-style participatory democracy and issue certificates to people who contributed to protecting democracy during the martial law imposition.

Indonesia, South Korea search for missing crew members after ship sinks

Jakarta, July 22 : The Indonesian government is working with South Korean authorities to locate two Indonesian crew members who went missing after their ship sank in waters off Jeju, South Korea, on Wednesday morning. The missing Indonesians, identified by the initials YM and SJU, were among the 27 crew members, 16 Koreans and 11 Indonesians, aboard the fishing vessel Geumseong Susan 135, which sank at around 4:33 a.m. local time. "Initial reports indicate the ship sank during the transfer of the fish catch to a transport vessel."



China: Eight dead, 34 missing after mountain collapse hits Chongqing

Beijing, July 22 : Eight people have been confirmed dead, and 34 others remain missing after a rainfall-induced mountain collapse occurred along a section of the Wujiang River in southwest China's Chongqing Municipality on Wednesday, local authorities said. Ten people have been rescued, and search and rescue operations are underway, according to a press briefing held on Friday night, Xinhua news agency reported. China activated a Level-II national emergency response for geological disasters after a landslide struck southwest China's Chongqing Municipality, causing houses to collapse and leaving people trapped, the

Ministry of Emergency Management said on Wednesday. The geological disaster saw massive amounts of rock and soil wash downslope at 9:08 a.m. on Friday, burying more than 10 residential buildings, while leaving some local residents trapped and unaccounted for. According to local authorities in Pengshui Miao and Tujia Autonomous County in Chongqing. The National Commission for Disaster Prevention, Reduction and Relief activated a Level-IV national disaster relief emergency response and sent a work team to assess the situation and assist local authorities in ensuring the basic living needs of affected residents.



'Don't think you're bigger than the game': Harbhajan reveals Sachin's career-changing advice

New Delhi, July 22 : Former India spinner Harbhajan Singh has revealed the most valuable piece of advice he received during his illustrious career, recalling how batting great Sachin Tendulkar urged him to stay focused on cricket and ignore the distractions that come with success. Harbhajan, one of India's greatest off-spinners, said Tendulkar's words have remained with him throughout his playing career and continue to shape the advice he now gives to the next generation of cricketers. "I think our seniors were so good because they wanted us to play well and become better within our limitations. The best advice I ever got was from the great Sachin Tendulkar," Harbhajan told Jio Star.



Ups and downs have been there, but have to follow process: Sooryavanshi

Harare, July 22 : Acknowledging that the last four months have been a rollercoaster of 'ups and downs,' teenage Indian batting sensation Vaibhav Sooryavanshi said his confidence still remains intact and he is focused on trusting his process ahead of the three-match T20I series against Zimbabwe starting on Thursday. Sooryavanshi, 15, made history during India's 4-0 T20I series defeat in England by becoming the country's youngest-ever international cricketer and breaking Sachin Tendulkar's long-standing record. However, after failing to cross 20 in three innings, he was dropped for the final match of the series in Southampton. "Yes, kaafi ups and downs aaye hain 4 mahine mein (there have been several ups and down in the last four months). It's part of cricket, it will keep happening. But I have to follow the process and give my 100 per cent for the team. "It's an obvious thing that whatever I want (guidance etc), the coaches are making it available and whatever practice I require I am getting that. Feeling very good, there is confidence also," said Sooryavanshi in a video posted on bcci.tv. Through the upcoming series against Zimbabwe, Sooryavanshi is also making a return to the Harare Sports Club.



Sammy confident of skipper Chase being fit for West Indies' first Test against Pakistan

Bridgetown, July 22 : West Indies head coach Daren Sammy is confident that Test captain Roston Chase will recover in time from a finger injury to lead the side in the opening Test against Pakistan, starting on July 25. Chase was forced to sit out the recently concluded three-match ODI series against New Zealand after sustaining an injury to his right index finger. Despite some lingering swelling, Sammy expressed optimism about the all-rounder's availability for the series opener. "I spoke to Roston earlier today. He came to do his workout. Still a little bit puffy. But Roston is a fighter. I know he's not going to want to miss any Test cricket. I'm pretty sure Dr Byam (team physio Denis Byam) has a way of keeping guys on the park.



Madhevere, Nyamhuri return as Zimbabwe name squad for T20Is against India

Harare, July 22 : Uncapped wicketkeeper-batter Tafadzwa Tsiga has earned his maiden T20I call-up, while all-rounder Wessly Madhevere and pacer Newman Nyamhuri returned to the 15-member Zimbabwe squad for the three-match series against India, starting here on Thursday. The trio come into the squad in place of Clive Madande, Tinotenda Maposa, and Tashinga Musekiwa, who were part of the side that recently faced Bangladesh. All three

matches of the series will be played at the Harare Sports Club on July 23, 25, and 26. Tsiga, who has represented Zimbabwe in 10 Tests, is yet to make his white-ball international debut. Madhevere, a regular in the Test and ODI setups during the Bangladesh series, returns to the shortest format for the first time since July 2025, and has played 79 T20Is so far.



Warner pleads guilty to drink-driving in Sydney

Sydney, July 22 : Former Australia opener David Warner on Wednesday pleaded guilty to a drink-driving charge in a Sydney court and will be sentenced later this year. Warner, who currently serves as the captain of the Sydney Thunder franchise in Australia's domestic T20 Big Bash League (BBL), did not appear in person during the court proceedings. Instead, his legal counsel Bobby Hill appeared at the

Sydney court to formally enter a guilty plea on his behalf to one count of 'middle range' drink-driving. The incident unfolded when on April 5, also Easter Sunday, Warner, behind the wheel of a van, drew attention after stopping short of a random breath-testing site. Warner had returned him mid-season from Pakistan, where he was captaining the Karachi Kings franchise in the Pakistan Super League (PSL). Police officers then took his roadside breath test, where Warner recorded more than double the legal blood alcohol limit.



Kuldeep Yadav signs for Yorkshire for One-Day Cup and County Championship games

Leeds, July 22 : Premier Indian left-arm wrist-spinner Kuldeep Yadav has signed with English county side Yorkshire as an overseas player for the ongoing domestic season, the club announced on Wednesday.

As per the deal, Kuldeep will feature in five One-Day Cup fixtures before returning to Headingley to play three of Yorkshire's final four County Championship matches in September. His stint begins from Friday's 50-over match against Glamorgan at Neath. Kuldeep was recently a part of India's 2-1 ODI series defeat in England, where he didn't get to play a single game, a decision which left many baffled. "I'm really pleased to be joining Yorkshire and grateful for this opportunity. It will be a real privilege to represent a club with Yorkshire's proud history. "I've always enjoyed the challenge of playing in English conditions, and after speaking with the management, I became really excited to join up with the team.
