AP Govt. Good news for farmers and Kharif crop insurance period extended

Amaravati, Aug 3: Andhra Pradesh Government has given good news to farmers. It has announced that the insurance period for Kharif crops is being extended. It has clarified that the insurance registration period for Kharif crops has been extended by another 15 days. It has been revealed that the deadline that was supposed to end on July 31 has been given another 15 days. The AP government has clarified that it is providing insurance protection for crop losses due to natural disasters, floods and lack of rain. The AP government has explained that it is providing crop insurance facility to farmers at a premium



of Rs. 1. It has advised farmers who have not registered yet to register for insurance immediately. It has appealed to register for insurance for every acre cultivated. The AP government has stated that registration can be done through banks, CSC centers, farmer service centers and NCIP mobile apps.

PK wins Bankipur, ends BJP's dominance; Samrat Choudhary congratulates him

Patna, Aug 3 : Jan Suraj founder Prashant Kishor has registered a major victory in the Bankipur Assembly by-election, defeating BJP candidate Neeraj Kumar Sinha by a margin of 18,963 votes and break-

ing the BJP's long-standing dominance over the constituency. According to the Election Commission, after the completion of all 31 rounds of counting, Prashant Kishor secured 63,203 votes, while BJP's Neeraj Kumar polled 44,250 votes. RJD candidate Rekha Kumari Gupta finished a

distant third with 14,085 votes. The victory marks the first electoral win of Prashant Kishor's political career and is being viewed as a significant development in Bihar politics. Bihar Chief Minister Samrat Choudhary congratulated Kishor on his victory.

Revanth congratulates NIMS Medical team

Hyderabad, Aug 3 : Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy has expressed profound delight over successfully performing 1,000 robotic surgeries by the NIMS medical team in just two and a half years. In a statement on Monday, the Chief Minister

congratulated NIMS Director Rahul Devaraj, medical team, nursing staff and the operation theatre team for the extraordinary achievement in the medical field. During the meeting with the NIMS Director, Revanth Reddy said the People's government's re-

Uttam orders time-bound approvals for four major irrigation projects

Hyderabad, Aug 3 : Minister for Irrigation and Civil Supplies N. Uttam Kumar Reddy has directed officials to implement a time-bound action plan to secure all pending environmental clearances for four flagship irrigation projects that include the Palamuru-Rangareddy Lift Irrigation Scheme (PRLIS), Sitarama Sagar, Dindi, and Gouravelli. The directive follows a recent Supreme Court ruling estab-



lishing updated procedural guidelines for environmental approvals. Chairing a high-level review meeting at the Secretariat on Monday, Uttam Kumar Reddy said the judgment had provided ample clarity on the legal position concerning projects.

KTR threatens protest at Rahul Gandhi's residence over 'unfulfilled' promises

Hyderabad, Aug 3 : Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) working president K.T. Rama Rao on Monday threatened to lay siege to Leader of Opposition Rahul Gandhi's residence in Delhi to demand that the Congress government in Telangana fulfil promises made to the youth, including the promise of 2 lakh

jobs. The former minister slammed Rahul Gandhi and Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy for not fulfilling the promise of providing jobs and other promises made in the youth declaration. Addressing a press conference, he accused the Congress government of pushing the youth of Telangana towards despair. He recalled that Rahul Gandhi had promised 2 lakh jobs in the first year and claimed that not even 10,000 jobs have been filled in two years. He said when there are

20,000 vacancies in the police department, the government has issued notifications for only 7,000 jobs. "Congress deceived people with its pre-election declarations. Even the 'Job Calendar' tabled in the legislature has gone nowhere," he said. He said that not even one out of 24 commitments under the Youth and Student Declarations has been fulfilled.



Handloom Competes with Power Loom...

Rajanna Sircilla, Aug 3: On the occasion of National Handloom Day, Veldi Hariprasad, a handloom weaver from Sircilla, achieved a remarkable feat driven by the resolve to showcase the talent of Sircilla’s weavers to the

world. While weaving a single handloom saree typically takes about a day, he astonished everyone by weaving an entire saree on a traditional handloom in just 170 minutes (2 hours and 50 minutes). Furthermore, he demonstrated his exceptional skill by folding the saree—which measured 5.5 meters in length and 45 inches in width and weighed 175 grams—and placing it inside an ordinary matchbox in the presence of dignitaries. Notably, the creation of this saree involved the use of ap-



proximately 10,500 weft (horizontal) threads and 1,500 warp (vertical) threads. Achieving this rare feat on a traditional handloom—rivaling the speed of a power loom—has become a major topic of discussion within the handloom sector. Several



prominent figures praised this remarkable achievement by Hariprasad, describing it as a testament to the skill, patience, and dedication of handloom weavers. They expressed hope that this innovative feat would earn a place in international record books, such as the Guinness World Records.

Reviewing the arrangements, the Chief Secretary said the Independence Day celebrations are among the most significant official events of the State and should be organised with meticulous planning, seamless co-ordination and utmost dignity, befitting the spirit of the nation's freedom. He informed the officials that, as part of the Independence Day programme, the Chief

Minister will first pay floral tributes to the martyrs at the Veerula Sainik Smarak at Parade Grounds, Secunderabad. Thereafter, the Chief Minister will proceed to the Rani Mahal Lawns, Golconda Fort, where he will participate in the State-level Independence Day celebrations, unfurl the National Flag, inspect the ceremonial parade and address the gathering. The Chief Secretary directed all departments concerned to make elaborate and foolproof arrangements for the smooth conduct of the celebrations. He stressed that every aspect of the event, including security, traffic regulation, venue readiness, public convenience and emergency response, should be planned well in advance to ensure a flawless execution of the programme. Sanjay Jaju instructed the Roads & Buildings department to complete all venue-related infrastructure works, including the stage, seating arrangements, barricading, approach roads and other civil works.

TN: GCC faces mounting cash crunch as deficit nears Rs 2,000 crore amid rising civic expenditure

Chennai, Aug 3 : The Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) is grappling with a widening fiscal deficit as expenditure continues to outpace revenue, placing mounting pressure on the civic body's finances and affecting its ability to meet payment obligations. Despite maintaining relatively stable revenue collections, the Corporation's overall deficit touched Rs 1,763 crore in the 2025-26 financial year and increased to Rs 1,970 crore after accounting for principal loan repayments, said of-



ficials. The financial strain has been driven by a sharp increase in revenue expenditure, which rose from Rs 3,581 crore in 2022-23 to Rs 5,676 crore in 2025-26. Officials attributed the surge to higher operational costs, including conservancy services, Design-Build-Finance-Operate-Transfer (DBFOT) public conveniences.

Andhra: YSRCP demands inquiry into relaxation of tender norms by TTD

Tirupati, Aug 3 : The YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) has demanded an inquiry into the relaxation of bidding qualifications for the supply of medicines and medical equipment to hospitals run by the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam (TTD). The opposition party alleged that the relaxation of norms would lead to corruption and compromise the quality of medicines and medical equipment. Speaking to the media, former TTD Chairman and YSRCP leader Bhumana Karunakar Reddy said the TTD Governing Board had decided to relax the eligibility criteria for bidding companies from Rs 100 crore to Rs 25 crore for the supply of medicines and medical equipment to TTD-run hospitals. In certain categories, the turnover requirement has been brought down further to Rs 15 crore, he said. The former MLA alleged that this was done under the instructions of Minister Nara Lokesh, despite objections raised by a Board member representing a reputed pharmaceutical company. He said the quality of medicines and medical equipment would be compromised and claimed the decision was taken

only to facilitate kickbacks. Even life-saving drugs and high-value medical equipment would be procured under the diluted norms, he alleged. He said the decision was based on the recommendations of an anonymous committee headed by Jagadish, whose role in the process has raised serious questions. Setting aside the norms followed by AIIMS and other premier medical institutions and allowing companies with much lower turnover to participate only reflected corrupt intentions, he alleged, adding that the argument of encouraging greater participation "cuts no ice." YSRCP SC Cell State President and former MLA T.J.R. Sudhakar Babu also criticised the government, alleging that the Chandrababu administration was using



false cases and diversionary politics to suppress questions over irregularities in DSC-2025 and protect Education Minister Nara Lokesh. He said Alur MLA Virupakshi, an elected leader from the weaker sections, was arrested like a terrorist in a midnight police raid after he went to protect a YSRCP worker attacked by TDP cadres. A viral video showed TDP worker Nagaraju tearing his wife's nightdress in the presence of police to frame the MLA.

Tamil Nadu transfers TNEB hard disk theft case to CBCID amid conspiracy allegations

Chennai, Aug 3 : The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board (TNEB) hard disk theft case, which triggered a major political controversy and raised concerns over the possible compromise of sensitive official data, has been transferred to the Crime Branch-Criminal Investigation Department (CBCID) for a detailed probe. The case came to light after 34 computer hard disks went missing from the Information Technology section of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board's headquarters on Anna Salai in Chennai. The disappearance of the storage devices sparked allegations from opposition parties.



Madras HC rejects Senthil Balaji's anticipatory bail plea in TASMAC corruption case

Chennai, Aug 3 : The Madras High Court on Monday rejected the anticipatory bail plea of former Tamil Nadu Minister and DMK MLA V. Senthil Balaji in the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption (DVAC) case alleging large-scale corruption in the functioning of the Tamil Nadu State Marketing Corporation (TASMAC). Dismissing the plea, Justice G.K. Ilanthiraiyan held that the nature of the allegations warranted custodial interrogation and observed that the case involved serious charges of large-scale corruption. The court also took note of the prosecution's claim that the accused had allegedly abused their offi-

cial positions, entered into a criminal conspiracy and caused substantial financial loss to the State exchequer. The case stems from an FIR registered by the DVAC on July 28 against Balaji and several others over alleged irregularities in TASMAC between 2021 and 2025, when he served as Minister for Electricity, Prohibition and Excise.

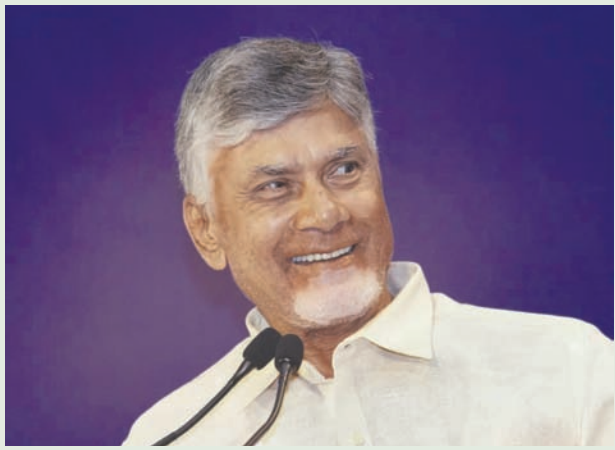

UN chief announces plans for new enlarged meeting on Cyprus issue

Nicosia, Aug 3 : United Nations (UN) Secretary-General Antonio Guterres on Monday announced plans to convene another enlarged meeting on the Cyprus issue following a tripartite meeting with Cypriot President Nikos Christodoulides and Turkish Cypriot leader Tufan Erhurman. Guterres arrived in Cyprus on Monday evening for his first visit to the island since taking office as UN Secretary-General. It was also the first visit by a sitting UN chief since Ban Ki-moon travelled to Cyprus in early 2010. Guterres said the enlarged meeting on the Cyprus issue will be convened "after adequate progress" is achieved on the matters of confidence-building measures, the meeting's methodology, and the substance of the talks, Xinhua news agency reported. He did not set a deadline, but said



there was a "consensus" among the two sides and the island's three guarantor powers -- Greece, Turkey and the United Kingdom - that such a meeting should be held. He stressed that the UN did not want "another enlarged meeting to end without result" and that "adequate preparation" should be made beforehand. Guterres met separately on Tuesday with Cypriot President, as well as Erhurman, and reaffirmed his commitment to supporting efforts to resolve the Cyprus issue. "This visit is a visit of solidarity to the people of Cyprus and to show my strong commitment to

make sure that we are able to have, finally, the solution in Cyprus," he said after meeting Christodoulides. He later met Erhurman.

Guterres said the pursuit of a solution "depends, obviously, on the Cypriots themselves," adding that "the guarantor powers also have a role to play," referring to Greece, Turkey and the United Kingdom under the 1960 Treaty of Guarantee.

Cyprus gained independence from British colonial rule in 1960. Under the arrangements governing its independence, Britain, Greece and Turkey were designated guarantor powers.

In 1974, a coup by Greek army officers aimed at uniting Cyprus with Greece prompted a Turkish military intervention, leaving the island divided.

The United Nations has maintained a long-standing peacekeeping force in Cyprus and has repeatedly mediated talks between the Greek Cypriot and Turkish Cypriot communities.

Concerns grow over fair trial standards at Bangladesh's International Crimes Tribunal

New York, Aug 3 : Leading US advocacy group Human Rights Watch (HRW) on Monday accused Bangladesh authorities of failing to uphold international legal standards at the country's International Crimes Tribunal (ICT), warning that such failures risk denying justice to victims, undermine the rule of law and result in unjust imprisonment of political opponents. The remarks came after ICT prosecution on Monday.



India and Bangladesh work on strengthening people-to-people ties, mutual understanding

Dhaka, Aug 3 : India's High Commissioner to Bangladesh, Pranay Verma held a meeting with Bangladesh's Minister of Information and Broadcasting Zahir Uddin Swapon on Monday, discussing cooperation in the information and broadcasting domain. During the meeting, two sides agreed to exchange visits of media delegations between India and Bangladesh to strengthen people-to-people ties and promote mutual understanding. Verma reiterated India's willingness to work with Bangladesh government to strengthen people-centric cooperation in all sectors.

"High Commissioner Pranay Verma paid a courtesy call on Minister of Information and Broadcasting of Bangladesh H.E. Zahir Uddin Swapon on 13 April 2026. They discussed wide-ranging cooperation in in-

formation and broadcasting domain, including engagements between media and broadcasting institutions of the two countries. They agreed to enhance exchange visits of media delegations between the two countries to strengthen people-to-people relations and promote mutual understanding," Indian High Commission in Bangladesh posted on X. "High Commissioner proposed various capacity building initiatives for journalists and media professionals under ITEC programme of Government of India. As part of these initiatives, a special training course for women journalists from Bangladesh will soon be organised in India. They also exchanged views on cooperation in films, including organization of film screening and film festivals in each other's country, as well as collaboration in production and post-production technological



support. High Commissioner reiterated India's willingness to work with the Government and people of Bangladesh to strengthen people-centric cooperation in all domains based on mutual interest and mutual benefit," it added.

Last week, Verma had called on Bangladesh's Minister of Civil Aviation and Tourism Afroza Khanum Rita, discussing enhancing bilateral cooperation in civil

aviation. Bangladesh' Minister of State for Civil Aviation and Tourism M Rashiduzzaman Millat also attended the meeting.

Pakistan passport fourth weakest in world after Iraq, Syria and Afghanistan

Islamabad, Aug 3 : Pakistan's passport has been ranked as the fourth weakest in the world in the latest Henley Passport Index with only Iraq, Syria and Afghanistan placed below. Among 199 different passports assessed by the firm, Pakistan's passport stood at the 101st spot in the world. As per the latest rankings, people of Pakistan can have visa-free or visa-on-arrival entry at only 29 destinations. The UK-

based citizenship and residence advisory company compares 199 different passports across 227 different travel destinations, and assesses the score on the basis of the number of places that can be visited without a prior visa, or with a visa on arrival. The three countries with weaker passports than Pakistan are Iraq, Syria and Afghanistan. As per the Henley Index, Pakistani citizens can have visa-free entry in Dominica, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Vanuatu, Trinidad and Tobago, Barbados, Haiti, Cook Islands, Rwanda, Micronesia, Montserrat and The Gambia, leading Pakistani network Geo News reported.

Stabbing spree in New York's Penn Station; five injured

New York, Aug 3 : Five people were stabbed at New York Penn Station, with at least one sustaining serious injuries, local media reported. The incident occurred on Sunday night (Local time). The five victims were rushed to a local hospital, reports CBS News, quoting the Fire Department of New York City. A suspect was quickly taken into custody, the authorities said. Police sources told CBS that the suspect is believed to have mental health issues. A criminal investigation is still underway, and no signs of ter-



rorism have been reported so far, reports Xinhua news agency, quoting CBS News. Police urged the public to avoid the area due to expected traffic delays, road closures and mass transit disruptions.

PM Modi's visit takes India-New Zealand bilateral ties into new phase

New Delhi, Aug 3 : India's relationship with New Zealand has entered a new phase following Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit, the first to the country by an Indian Premier in two decades, according to an article published by NZIIA (New Zealand Institute of International Affairs). The article highlights that during the two-day visit, PM Modi and New Zealand Prime Minister Christopher Luxon upgraded the ties between the two countries to a full Strategic Partnership, backed by a four-year "Roadmap to 2030" spanning defence, trade, maritime security, agriculture, tourism, sports, culture and science. India has gained importance in New Zealand's long-term strategy as the country us among the fastest-growing major economies and is projected to become the world's third-largest economy by 2030.





South Korean Prez Lee, Polish PM hold summit talks with focus on defense industry cooperation

Seoul, Aug 3 : South Korean President Lee Jae Myung and Polish Prime Minister Donald Tusk held summit talks on Monday to discuss ways to expand bilateral cooperation, with defense ties likely to be high on the agenda. Lee held his first in-person talks with Tusk at Cheong Wa Dae, to be followed by a joint press announcement and an official luncheon. Expanding strategic cooperation across various sectors, especially in the defense industry, is expected to be a central focus of the summit. In December, Poland signed a 5.6 trillion-won (\$4 billion) contract with South Korean defense company Hanwha Aerospace Co. to import Chunmoo multiple launch rocket systems. The two leaders will also discuss the Middle East crisis and

other major geopolitical developments as Poland is a key member of the European Union and North Atlantic Treaty Organization, presidential spokesperson Kang Yujung said. Tusk arrived in South Korea on Sunday for a two-day visit, marking the first bilateral trip to the country by a Polish prime minister in 27 years. For Tusk's official visit, Lee prepared a smartwatch equipped with healthcare and artificial intelligence functions, reflecting the premier's hobbies, including soccer and running, according to Lee's office, Yonhap news agency reported. Lee also prepared a Korean traditional hanbok-style cloak for Tusk's pet dog, a calligraphy piece and a traditional Korean bronze ware cutlery set.

Trump faults Fed after decision to hold interest rates steady

Washington, Aug 3 : US President Donald Trump has criticised the Federal Reserve for leaving interest rates unchanged, saying lower borrowing costs would further strengthen an economy that he claimed was already attracting record levels of investment. Speaking at the White House on Sunday (local time), Trump praised Federal Reserve Governor Kevin Warsh but suggested the central bank's board had prevented interest rate cuts despite strong economic performance. Asked whether he was surprised by the Fed's decision to keep rates unchanged, Trump replied: "No, Kevin's fantastic." "Kevin's got a board. He's fantastic. He's a brilliant guy, smart." Trump added that Warsh supported lower interest rates but was constrained by other policymakers. "I

know he'd love to see lower interest rates, but he's got a board, and it's a political board, and they want to keep rates up." The President argued that the US economy was performing at an unprecedented level despite higher borrowing costs. "But we fight through rates." "We have the greatest -- we have the strongest investment ever made in a country, of any country." Trump claimed the United States had attracted \$19.2 trillion in investment commitments over the past year, comparing it with previous records. "It was China about 13, 14 years ago. We have far greater." "\$19.2 trillion. It's the biggest number ever spent in any country, by far, and that's over a period of one year." He contrasted those figures with investment during the previous administration.



Anthony Fauci invokes Fifth Amendment during Senate hearing as Covid row returns

Washington, Aug 3 : Former top US infectious disease expert Anthony Fauci repeatedly invoked his Fifth Amendment right against self-incrimination before a sharply divided Senate committee, as Republican lawmakers revived allegations over US-funded coronavirus research at China's Wuhan Institute of Virology and sought answers on the origins of the Covid-19 pandemic. The hearing before the Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee on Sunday (local time) quickly became a fierce partisan confrontation, with Chairman Rand Paul accusing Fauci of helping fund "dangerous gain-of-function research" in Wuhan and later announcing that the committee would consider holding him in contempt for refusing to answer questions despite

appearing under subpoena. Fauci, who led the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases for nearly four decades, began the hearing by saying he had testified before Congress "well over 200 times" during his career. He said Senator Paul's repeated calls for his prosecution left him with "the only conclusion" that the hearing was intended to force him to say "something, anything" that could support those efforts. "Under the advice of my attorneys, I will invoke my right under the Fifth Amendment of the Constitution to refrain from answering your questions," Fauci said. Throughout several hours of questioning, Fauci responded to virtually every question with the same statement: "On the advice of counsel, I respectfully decline to answer based upon my rights under the Fifth Amendment of the Constitution."

Philippines Ambassador hails India as one of 'top partners' after BrahMos missile rollout

Washington, Aug 3 : The Philippines Ambassador to the United States, Jose Manuel del Gallego Romualdez, highlighted the strength of the India-Philippines relationship, calling New Delhi "one of Manila's top partners and friends." At a private event on Monday evening in Washington, Romualdez highlighted

India's sale of BrahMos missiles to the Philippines as evidence of a strong defence partnership. "We look at India now as one of our top partners and friends. They have been very supportive of the Philippines... We are actually buying quite many defence equipment like BrahMos and are also working with India on the technology side," he added. His statement comes days after the Philippine

Marine Corps publicly unveiled India's BrahMos supersonic cruise missile system. The \$375 million deal signed in 2022 with India's BrahMos Aerospace provides the Philippines with missiles capable of striking targets up to 290 kilometres, strengthening its deterrence in the South China Sea. The system is operated by the Shore-Based Anti-Ship Missile Battalion as part of the Philip-

ppines' broader military modernisation efforts. The Ambassador also recalled Philippine President Ferdinand Marcos' visit to India in August and called it a "very fruitful" trip. "Our President had a recent state visit to India not too long ago. It was a very fruitful visit that we had. So, we look forward to working with India." Marcos met Prime Minister Narendra Modi and other

senior officials during a 5-day visit, and the two sides announced an upgraded strategic partnership aimed at deepening cooperation in trade, defence, and maritime security. They also agreed to expand collaboration in space, tourism, culture, and digital technologies. Measures included Indian support for a pilot project to establish the Philippines' Sovereign Data Cloud Infrastructure.



South Africa reopens border crossing with Mozambique



Cape Town, Aug 3 : Traveller movement at South Africa's main border crossing point with Mozambique is now open "until further notice," the country's Border Management Authority (BMA) announced.

UK lawmakers seek independent probe into human rights abuses by Pakistani forces in PoK

London, Aug 3 : Several British parliamentarians expressed grave concern over the escalating unrest in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK), where over 40 civilians were killed and dozens critically injured in a brutal crackdown by Pakistani security forces. British Labour Party MP Liam Byrne said that reports of live fire being used against peaceful protesters in PoK are "deeply alarming". Describing the communications blackout and human rights abuse in the occupied territory as "completely unacceptable".

China's deepening role in Iran conflict signals 'dangerous escalation': Report

Washington, Aug 3 : China does not benefit from an outright Iranian win but from Tehran's continued ability to distract, complicate, and impose costs on United States power projection. This makes the relationship between Beijing and Tehran "more dangerous than simple arms sales" as it evolves into a form of strategic burden-sharing against the US, sustained through proxies, sanctions evasion, and plausible deniability, a report said on Monday. According to a report on 'One World Outlook', China has moved beyond the role of a distant benefactor of Iran. It stated that if the US intelligence reports are accurate, Beijing is edging towards "something more dangerous: active enabling of Iran's wartime rebuild". Citing a CNN report, it noted the US intelligence assesses that China is preparing to supply air-defence systems to Iran in the coming weeks, possibly using third countries to conceal the source. "This is not a

story about symbolism. It is about capability. Air-defence systems, anti-ship missiles, and dual-use industrial inputs can change the way a war is fought. They can make it harder for the United States and its allies to operate in the region, complicate surveillance and strike options, and help Iran replenish losses inflicted by weeks of conflict. In war, logistics and replacement pipelines can matter as much as battlefield bravado. A state that helps restore those pipelines is not standing on the sidelines; it is shaping outcomes," the report detailed. "That is why these reports should alarm policymakers in Washington, Jerusalem, and across the Gulf. China has long presented itself as a pragmatic power, one that prefers commerce, diplomacy, and stability to ideological confrontation. Yet the reported behaviour suggests a more cynical approach: Beijing appears willing to profit from Iran's isolation while quietly strengthening Tehran's military hand," it added. According to the report, American think tank 'The Atlantic



Council' documented Chinese supplies of drones, missiles, and related components to Iran, indicating a sustained channel rather than a sudden rupture. It also cited British media outlet BBC similarly reporting that US intelligence alleges Chinese support for Iran's ballistic missile efforts through training and key components. The report noted that if substantiated, the development would constitute a "dangerous escalation" in China's involvement. "Beijing may argue that air-defence systems are defensive, not offensive. That argument is technically neat and strategically misleading. A missile system labelled 'defensive' can still threaten aircraft, drones, and naval platforms. In a conflict zone, the defensive-offensive distinction often collapses under the realities of use," it stressed.

Gehlot making unnecessary remarks to divert attention: Rajasthan BJP

Jaipur, Aug 3 : Reacting to a recent statement by former Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot, BJP State President Madan Rathore on Monday said that Gehlot is making baseless and unnecessary remarks against the BJP in an attempt to divert attention from the internal strife and failures within his own party. Rathore stated that the Bharatiya Janata Party is a disciplined and well-organised political party where leaders ex-

press their views responsibly. He advised Gehlot to reflect before commenting on the BJP’s internal matters, especially when his own party continues to face persistent leadership uncertainty. Rathore remarked that Gehlot had to resort to “hotel confinement”

to safeguard his government during that period. Referring to senior BJP leader Vasundhara Raje, he said her leadership and contributions are well-recognised and undisputed within the party. Gehlot’s remarks, he said, reflect sheer political opportunism. Rathore further emphasised that India’s foreign policy has been strong, balanced, and firmly rooted in national interest. He said India has emerged as a

decisive global leader, earning appreciation worldwide. ? He termed it unfortunate that Gehlot questioned India’s global standing by drawing comparisons with Pakistan, stating that such remarks are not only inappropriate but also harm the nation’s image internationally. Rathore also said that while the Congress party claims to be united in Rajasthan, the reality reflects deep-rooted factionalism.



He pointed out that internal differences among senior Congress leaders, including Ashok Gehlot, Govind Singh Dotasra, Tikaram Jolly, and Sachin Pilot, continue to surface frequently.

Medinipur BLOs protest over data entry work under SIR, submit memorandum to BDO

The conclave was attended by global experts and academicians from 11 nations to present, deliberate and attempt to find sustainable solutions to the contemporary challenges in the maritime sector of the world. While India remained

in focus, the global historians and maritime experts put an onus on the country’s more than 5,000-year-old history for shared growth at the conclave. Sonowal said that India's maritime rise is a testament to the nation's progress and resurgence as a major global power. “From enhanced port operations and logistics to mega-infrastructure development, India is earning global recognition as it aims to be-

come a major maritime nation by 2030,” the minister said. He added that the exploration of our rich maritime history, especially with the upcoming National Maritime Heritage Complex (NMHC) in Lothal, is reshaping the world's perspective on India's shipping sector. “At IMHC, we are creating

Kerala Planning Board 2023 top rank candidate under SIT lens as PSC scam probe intensifies

Thiruvananthapuram, Aug 3 : The Special Investigation Team (SIT) investigating alleged irregularities in Kerala Public Service Commission (PSC) recruitments has turned its focus to the Planning Board examination, where investigators are prob-



ing allegations that the answer script of the candidate who secured the first rank in 2023 and is now employed in the State Planning Board was allegedly manipulated. The allegation has emerged as the most significant finding in the probe so far. The PSC exam was held on July 13, 2023, for the post of Chief (Industry and Infrastructure), State Planning Board. According to sources, the SIT suspects that 10 questions carrying 58 marks were excluded from the evaluation process after it was found that the candidate had answered six of them incorrectly and left four un-

answered. Investigators are examining whether the questions were subsequently dropped to protect the candidate's rank. The candidate is reported to have links with

a Left-affiliated organisation. These allegations remain under investigation. The SIT, headed by IG of Police Ajitha Beegum, has already registered an FIR in the case. However, no accused have been named so far, with investigators indicating that the probe has now entered a crucial phase aimed at identifying individual culpability. Sources said the investigation team will soon be expanded as it moves into its second stage.

Gujarat: 7 held in Ahmedabad weighbridge fraud; scam pegged at up to Rs 100 cr

Ahmedabad, Aug 3 : The Ahmedabad Crime Branch has arrested seven people for allegedly operating a sophisticated inter-state fraud involving manipulation of electronic weighbridge systems to cheat companies during scrap transactions, officials said on Monday. According to the Crime Branch, the gang was active across multiple states and committed fraud by tampering with electronic weighing machines used to weigh scrap material. The operation came to light following specific intelligence inputs, after which investigators conducted technical analysis and field inquiries. Police said the accused installed specialised chips in weighbridge machines, enabling them to interfere with the weight display system. They also used remote-control devices to alter readings and generate false weight slips that showed lower weights than the actual load. This allowed them to unlawfully gain during scrap purchases. Inspector Nikhil Brahmabhatt said, “In Gujarat and its neighbouring states such as Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, and Maharashtra, there are several scrap traders and large companies where scrap tenders are issued. In these tenders, a gang would place the highest bids and commit fraud. We have arrested seven members of this gang.” Investigators said the accused would participate in scrap tenders issued by companies and industrial units or acquire scrap through auction bidding. After securing deals, they allegedly tampered with weighbridge systems at the sites through associates with technical expertise, underreporting the actual weight of scrap and cheating scrapyard operators and site owners. Acting on precise information that gang members were gathering with illegal equipment in the Vatva GIDC area, a Crime Branch team conducted a raid and apprehended all seven accused from the location. A Crime Branch official told IANS, “We received specific inputs about their gathering. All seven were apprehended from Vatva GIDC in Ahmedabad.” An official added that the fraud is estimated



at between Rs 50 crore and Rs 100 crore and said that companies affected include Adani Group, Reliance Industries, and Essar, among others. "We have approached the companies to take part in the inquiry. We also suspect that employees such as security guards can be part of this operation," an official noted. The official further stated that the alleged mastermind has been identified as Rajnish Kashyap, a resident of Madhya Pradesh, who is currently absconding. “Two more individuals from Noida and New Delhi are believed to be linked to this fraud,” the official told IANS. The arrested accused have been identified as Hemantkumar Raval (33), Sanket Raval (24), Vijay Thakor (36), Manish Rabari (27), Vinod Patni (36), Mukesh Patni (31), and Sunil Patni (36). Police said they are residents of Ahmedabad and nearby districts, with native places in Mehsana, Sabarkantha, Banaskantha, Gandhinagar and Patan. Officials said six other persons have been named as wanted in the case, including Rajnish Kashyap, Chirag Goswami alias Chirag Bawa, Sunil Bodi, Vinod Champo.

AIMPLB welcomes SC's curbs on fresh suits against mosques

New Delhi, Aug 3 : The All India Muslim Personal Law Board (AIMPLB) on Monday welcomed the Supreme Court’s interim order on the Places of Worship Act, 1991 that imposed restrictions on registering new suits, delivering effective or final judgments, or ordering surveys in ongoing cases concerning mosques and shrines. AIMPLB Spokesperson S.Q.R. Ilyas welcomed the apex court’s interim order, emphasising that local courts were undermining the spirit of the Places of Worship Act by entertaining petitions and issuing orders concerning mosques, said a statement. “The manner in which local courts declared appeals admissible and issued orders on mosques and dargahs had made this act ineffective.



Union Minister urges researchers to use India-specific data for health challenges

Bhubaneswar, Aug 3 : India’s fight against diabetes and other rising metabolic disorders requires Indian data for Indian solutions, supported by long-term scientific evidence, said Union Minister for Science & Technology, Jitendra Singh, on Monday. The Union Minister made the remarks at the inauguration event of the National Conclave on Longitudinal Cohort Studies – “Cohort Connect 2025” at CSIR-IMMT, Bhubaneswar. The conclave focuses on advancing research into India’s genetic, environmental, and lifestyle determinants of health to enable personalised genetic-based treatments and preventive healthcare strategies. In his inaugural address, Singh said that the discussions taking place a day before World Diabetes Day carry special relevance, as metabolic disorders like diabetes are rapidly emerging as a major national health chal-

lenge. He emphasised that diabetes today represents not just a clinical condition but a complete spectrum of vascular, neurological, and renal complications, making scientific research in this domain critical for national planning. The minister emphasised that India continues to deal simultaneously with both communicable and non-communicable diseases, and the reciprocal link between diabetes and infections such as tuberculosis requires integrated policy responses rather than compartmentalised programmes. “India’s phenotypic uniqueness has been acknowledged for decades.



India's Q2 gold demand falls 6 pc; investment demand stays resilient

Mumbai, Aug 3: India's gold demand declined 6 per cent year-on-year (YoY) to 131.4 tonnes during the April-June quarter of 2026, as subdued seasonal demand, higher customs duty and a shift in consumer sentiment weighed on purchases, according to the World Gold Council's (WGC) latest Q2 2026 Gold Demand Trends report. The country's total gold demand stood at 131.4 tonnes in the quarter, down from 139.7 tonnes in the corresponding period last year, with jewellery consumption witnessing the sharpest decline. Jewellery demand fell 15 per cent year-on-year to 75.1 tonnes from 88.8 tonnes a year ago, as per the data. The decline also came after Prime Minister Narendra Modi, in May, urged citizens to curb non-

essential gold purchases and consider alternative savings avenues to help reduce pressure on the country's foreign exchange reserves amid rising import costs driven by volatile crude oil prices. "I would appeal to people not to buy gold for weddings for one year," PM Modi said in May amid the ongoing global crisis because of Middle East tensions. Meanwhile, gold and silver prices drop up to 1 per cent on MCX on Thursday due to profit booking ahead of US Fed policy decision. "The steady resilience of gold around the \$4080 mark reflects a market balancing two powerful forces – a hawkish monetary policy and an escalating geopolitical risk in the Middle East leading to further uncertainties in glo-

bal economy," an analyst stated. While the US Fed's firm decision to tackle inflation kept the rate unchanged and dialled back immediate September rate-hike expectations, the underlying safe-haven appeal of precious metal will likely get reignited. "However, the commitment of US Fed to a strict 2 per cent inflation target with no soft leeway, creates a tough short-term macroeconomic backdrop for bullion," as per the market expert.

Microsoft Q4 revenue rises 18 pc to \$90 billion, Azure annual revenue tops \$100 billion

New Delhi, Aug 3 : US-based technology giant Microsoft has posted a strong set of fourth-quarter and full-year results for fiscal 2026 driven by robust demand for its cloud and artificial intelligence (AI) offerings, with Azure annual revenue crossing the \$100 billion mark for the first time, according to the company. The tech giant posted fourth-quarter revenue of \$90 billion, up 18 per cent year-on-year, while operating income rose 18 per cent to \$40.6 billion. Meanwhile, net income climbed 31 per cent to \$35.8 billion on a GAAP basis, while diluted earnings per share (EPS) increased 32 per cent to \$4.81. On a non-GAAP basis, net income rose 22 per cent to \$35.3 billion and diluted EPS increased 23 per cent to \$4.74. Microsoft Cloud revenue surged 27 per cent to \$59.3 billion during the quarter. Revenue from the Intelligent Cloud segment rose 32 per cent

to \$39.3 billion, with Azure and other cloud services revenue jumping 43 per cent. "We are advancing the frontier on the cost-to-outcome curve, ensuring every customer can turn tokens into business results," said Microsoft Chairman and CEO Satya Nadella. "This year, Azure revenue surpassed \$100 billion for the first time, and Microsoft 365 Copilot reached over 30 million paid seats, reflecting the confidence customers are placing in us to power their AI transformation," he added. For the full fiscal year ended June 30, Microsoft reported revenue of \$331.8 billion, up 18 per cent.



GST officials detect Rs 645 crore ITC fraud in Delhi, kingpin of racket arrested

New Delhi, Aug 3 : The Directorate General of GST Intelligence (DGGI) has uncovered a massive case of fraudulently availing Input Tax Credit (ITC) to the tune of RS 645 crore through a web of 229 dummy GST-registered firms, controlled and operated by a Delhi-based syndicate. The kingpin of the racket has been arrested, according to an official statement issued on Monday. Acting on credible intelligence, DGGI officers of the Delhi Zone conducted a coordinated search operations at multiple premises across the national capital, unearthing a huge cache of incriminating documents, digital devices, and ledgers that established the operation of non-existent firms engaged in issuing invoices without actual supply of goods or services. "The seizures included 162 mobile phones, probably used to get OTPs for GST/banking purposes.

BMW to cut around 8,000 jobs in Germany by 2027 amid weak demand and cost pressures

New Delhi, Aug 3 : German luxury carmaker BMW on Monday announced plans to cut several thousand jobs in Germany by the end of 2027 through a voluntary redundancy programme, becoming the latest automaker to reduce its workforce amid weakening demand, mounting cost pressures and a challenging transition to electric vehicles. The company said the severance programme, agreed with the works council, will

primarily affect employees in its administration and development divisions, while production operations will remain unaffected. According to multiple reports, BMW's workforce in Germany is expected to shrink by around 8,000 employees.



Govt seeks detailed explanation from Meta over temporary restriction of PM Modi's Facebook post

New Delhi, Aug 3 : The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) has asked senior officials from Meta to appear before the government to explain the temporary restriction placed on Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Facebook post, with the meeting expected to take place within the next seven to 10 days. Speaking on the matter, MeitY Secretary S. Krishnan said the government is seeking both a policy-level and

technical explanation from the social media company to understand how the incident occurred. "India intends to convey its concerns directly to Meta and obtain a comprehensive account of the circumstances that led to the brief restriction," he said. "Meta has already conveyed its regret over the

incident and provided a preliminary explanation to the government. However, the Centre has sought a more detailed clarification, including the measures the company is putting in place to ensure such incidents do not recur," Krishnan stated. The latest move comes a day after the gov-



ernment summoned a senior Meta executive following the temporary restriction.

Characters like Virat Kohli keep cricket alive, says former umpire Anil Chaudhary

New Delhi, Aug 3 : Former international umpire Anil Chaudhary believes high-energy personalities like Virat Kohli are vital for the sport to retain its charm, while revealing that the star batter acts aggressively out of pure competitive spirit without any malice.

Kohli, who recently played in India's 2-1 ODI series loss to England, will be next seen in action during the series against the West Indies in September. "Actually, my advantage with Virat was that I had officiated his matches since childhood, so I have known him for a long time. He doesn't have any malice.

"He reacts aggressively sometimes, but if you're right, he'll give you a thumbs up too. Between overs, he'll come over and put a hand around your waist. But he is lively throughout. Players like him should be there; otherwise, the game will get boring," Chaudhary said on JioHotstar. Reflecting on the fiery on-field altercations in the IPL, including the famous heated exchange between Kohli and Gautam Gambhir in 2013, Chaudhary noted that aggression is intrinsic to northern players and brings a unique flavour to the game, provided it stays within limits.



All-format batters an illusion, cricket needs dedicated specialist squads: Cullinan

New Delhi, Aug 3 : Former South Africa batter Daryll Cullinan believes modern cricket is fooling itself by expecting players to excel across all three formats, adding that the era of the true multi-format batter is effectively over and that dedicated specialist squads are urgently needed to preserve the integrity of the game. Writing in his column, the former Proteas veteran asserted that modern scheduling,

commercial demands, and T20-centric coaching methods have created a generation of batters with a 'hybrid technique' that crumbles when exposed to demanding Test conditions. "Producing a batter equally accomplished across all three formats of the game is no longer achievable in cricket. Such a player represents a batting pinnacle that asks too much, and performances have suggested this for long now.

Indian-origin Neel Patel named in Australia U19 squad for India tour

Melbourne, Aug 3 : Indian-origin cricketer Neel Patel has been named in Australia's Under-19 men's squad for a multi-format tour of India, with fast bowlers Will Byrom and Kasey Barton will spearhead the 16-member team for the subcontinent tour next month.

The tour will include three 50-over matches and two four-day matches against India Under 19s in Rajkot and Ahmedabad.

Representing the University of New South Wales (UNSW) Cricket Club, Neel became one of the youngest players to score more than 1000 runs in Sydney Premier Cricket First Grade in a calendar year at the age of 16.

Byrom and Barton, meanwhile, are the only two members of the squad to feature at the U19 World Cup earlier this year in Zimbabwe. The then-17-year-old Byrom starred with 10 wickets at 10.50,

while Barton took four wickets as the Aussies ultimately lost to England in the semi-final by 27 runs. "We are really pleased to provide the opportunity to some of Australia's best young players to continue their development as part of our pathways program," Sonya Thompson. Touring India and playing against high-quality opposition in challenging conditions will be a valuable experience and test the players technically and

mentally across formats," Cricket Australia Head of National Development, said in a statement.

He made his professional debut at 16 years old, after rising through the academy ranks, and won numerous titles before moving to England in 2024 to join Brighton & Hove Albion. During his time on the Sussex coast, he enjoyed loan spells at Sevilla and RC Strasbourg, joining the latter on a permanent basis after a 2024/25 campaign in which he enjoyed a breakthrough spell and helped Strasbourg secure European football. Barco contributed to 12 goals in 43 appearances across all competitions last term.



Markram plays down LSG captaincy talk, says franchise has 'quality leaders'

London, Aug 3 : South Africa T20I captain Aiden Markram has played down speculation surrounding the vacant leadership position at Lucknow Super Giants (LSG), stating that he has not given captaining in the Indian Premier League (IPL) much thought and cited that the franchise possesses several 'quality leaders.' The leadership spot at LSG has been vacant after Rishabh Pant stepped down in May following the franchise finishing at the bottom of the points table in IPL 2026, before being traded to Delhi Capitals (DC) in exchange for left-arm wrist-spinner Kuldeep Yadav.

Sports Minister Mandaviya lauds India's 39-medal haul at 'trimmed-down' CWG 2026

New Delhi, Aug 3 : Union Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports Mansukh Mandaviya has lauded India's fourth-place finish with 39 medals in the Commonwealth Games 2026 in Glasgow, a trimmed-down edition that featured just 10 sports, nine fewer

than at Birmingham 2022, where India won 30 medals. India's Glasgow 2026 campaign concluded with 39 medals – 13 gold, 17 silver and nine bronze. "Bharat signs off from the Commonwealth Games 2026 with a commendable 4th-place finish.

Despite Glasgow 2026 being a trimmed-down edition without several disciplines where India traditionally excels, Team India improved from 30 medals in the comparable disciplines at Birmingham 2022 to 39 medals this year. "Under the leadership of

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji, the growing depth and strength of Indian sport is clearly visible. Proud of every athlete, coach and support staff who gave their all for the Tricolour," Mandaviya posted on X.
